	Does the contract include mulch installation, or would that fall under a separate work order? In section 2.2.4 Mulching "a. The DPW Commissioner or Designee may direct the Contractor to apply mulch to beds and along lawn areas. The City will provide approved mulch to the Contractor." Is it definite that we will provide a mulch labor number as it uses the work "may"?	See p. 119, section 2.2.2 Weed Removal and 2.2.4 Mulching. The Contractor will touch up bark and mulch following weed removal. Any further mulch installation will be upon request, at the discretion of the DPW Commissioner or Designee. Mulch installation will be billed at the hourly labor rate indicated in Section B. of the Bid Form.		
2.	Can you provide the previous years contact for review? Can you please share previous bid results if any?	Please see the attached for bid results from the last bid cycle.		
3.	Regarding Prevailing Wages, would we be able to confirm that our workers would fit under the general "Laborer" category? What labor rate are we supposed to be using for the Prevailing Wage number? There are a few of them under laborer and I want to make sure I am using the correct one as this will affect our bid numbers. Can you confirm whether all landscaping work is fully subject to Massachusetts Prevailing Wage requirements?	Please utilize the "Laborer, Laborers-Zone 1" classification. This bid is subject to Massachusetts Prevailing Wages.		
4.	Will fertilization be required as part of the contract?	No. Fertilization is performed under a separate City contract.		
5.	Is the scope of the bid limited to mowing services only?	No. See p. 118, 2.2 Description of Services , and p. 121, 3.1 Locations . Services performed during each visit may vary at the discretion of the DPW Commissioner or Designee.		
6.	Can you confirm if this is a living wage contract?	City of Somerville Living Wage applies.		

7.	Is there any possibility of waiving or modifying the bid deposit and bonding requirements for these projects?	A 5% bid deposit is a statutory requirement and cannot be waived. A 50% Payment Bond will be required of the awarded vendor.
8.	I don't see anywhere in the RFP document to submit the 5% bid deposit –is this something I missed, or is there a dedicated area for us to submit a bid? (And to confirm, we would submit the 5% deposit along with our bid documents, correct?)	Please see page 11 of the bid package for details regarding the 5% bid deposit. The 5% bid deposit must be submitted with your bid.
9.	In both documents, there are references to getting permits, rodent control, police details, maintenance manuals, etc. I'm assuming that these do not apply to our bid since the bid specs don't mention any of them?	The Contractor will report any indication of rodent activity to the DPW Commissioner or Designee. Rodent control will be managed by the City. The sections on permits, police details, and maintenance manuals do not apply.
10.	Could I receive limits of work on 50 Cross St/ 5 Meacham St and 81 Highland? Our numbers are very different, and I would like to make sure we are on the same page.	See updated square footage estimates at these three locations below. Somerville High School, 81 Highland Ave.: 69,700 sqft East Somerville Community School, 50 Cross St.: 86,000 sqft Arthur D. Healey School, 5 Meacham St.: 34,000 sqft
