 - Elaine provided an overview of SHINE services within the State of MA, a program which provides services to over 35,000 people per year. This program is run primarily through volunteers and Elaine works directly for Minuteman Health.
 - The SHINE Program provides services to those new to Medicare, works with low to moderate income individuals, assists people with disabilities and assists with Medicare Savings Programs, which can help cover the Medicare monthly premium, and save on prescription coverage.
 - Both Social Workers at the COA are SHINE certified and we have access to additional volunteers during open enrollment. The Board expressed interest in having ongoing trainings for the community.
