Review Latest McGrath Blvd Design (45 Minutes)

- On March 25, 2025, <u>MassDOT's McGrath Boulevard project</u> team presented the latest designs for the project that will replace McGrath Highway with a street-level boulevard that's safe and comfortable for people walking, biking, taking the bus, and driving.
- At this PTAC meeting, Mobility staff will briefly summarize the changes made in these latest
 designs from those presented in February 2024. The committee's goal will be to provide feedback
 for a letter to the project team.

Letter Opportunity: Webster Ave Bridge Replacement Project (10 Minutes)

- In this project, MassDOT plans to replace the bridge on Webster Ave over the Green Line tracks and replace the <u>current skewed intersection at Newton St</u> with two "T" intersections. The project is already at 75% design with construction set to begin in Winter 2025/2026. Some community members have expressed concern that the current designs (<u>presented on March 20, 2025</u>) are ambiguous on whether the bridge will be reconstructed so as to allow for the Green Line to be extended west at some point in the future.
- At this PTAC meeting, we will discuss whether to write a letter to the MassDOT project team advocating for the project to accommodate a future Green Line extension.

Elm-Beacon Connector Traffic Signal Phasing (20 Minutes)

- At the March PTAC meeting, we discussed the City's <u>Elm-Beacon Connector project</u> but did not get a chance to dig into the proposed signal phasing changes.
