1.	Can you provide the pricing on this contract the last time it was awarded?	Please see the attached for the Price Form of the Awarded Vendor for IFB #23-12.
2.	Our product is similar to the product listed in the spec and meets all the criteria w/ some minor differences, e.g. Size of Trap, mode of action to kill the rodent. Is the City allowing for alternative products other than the proprietary SMART trap offered by Anticimex (Modern Pest)?  • Our Trap comes in (2) versions. Collect and Nature. The Collect Version kills and captures the rodent. The Nature Version kills the rodent and the rodent dies outside the trap.	We are allowing for similar products beyond products mentioned in the question. They should: track data in real-time, collect the carcasses, be weatherproof, poison-free and durable.
3.	The Scope of Service states the locations will be commercial, public, and residential.  A. Once the traps are installed, will they remain at each site/location for the year, or will the city request the traps be moved and reinstalled?  B. Will the vendor have input as to where the traps are installed based on data provided through 311 reporting or other sources?  C. A) Traps will be requested to be moved in a timely manner if deemed "inactive" or are damaged by human interaction. 6.	How many service calls has the previous vendor provided per Calander year? 2023, 2024, 2025-Date	On a rolling basis, when devices indicate a capture, the boxes are serviced within 3-5 business days. This could result in hundreds of service calls/year.

How many traps have been relocated after the initial installation within the course of a Calendar year? 2023, 2024, 2025-Date	All 60 boxes have been relocated at one point or another if they are not capturing a sufficient number of rodents. <5/two weeks would be considered low performance or inactive.
