Re: IFB 26-10 165 Broadway Slab Remediation Notice of Rejection of All Bids and Intent to Rebid

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30B, Section 9 and Section 1.5 of the Invitation for Bids (IFB) (General Terms; Right to Cancel/Reject Bids), the City of Somerville is rejecting all bids it has received in response to IFB 26-10 165 Broadway Slab Remediation.

The City of Somerville has determined that rejection of all bids and revising the scope of services serves the best interests of the City. Upon tabulation and review of all four (4) general bids received, it is apparent that all bids significantly exceeded the City's budget which was indicated on page 2 of the bid package under "Key Project Information". The City is revising the project scope to remove parts of the scope and will re-issue a bid package in October 2025.

The City of Somerville appreciates the time and effort it takes to prepare and respond to a public bid and regrets any inconvenience this may have caused. The re-bid of this IFB with a revised scope will be advertised soon. All bidders will be notified when the new IFB is released and are encouraged to submit a bid for the revised scope of services.
