Discussion on Autonomous Vehicles with MassDOT (25 Minutes)

Kristopher Carter, Chief Possibility Officer at MassDOT, will present on autonomous vehicles (AVs, aka self-driving cars) from MassDOT's perspective. He'll touch on the current state of AVs nationwide, existing approaches to AV policy and regulations in Massachusetts, and future paths AVs could take in the state. A discussion among PTAC members will follow.

Review of Western Pearl Street 80% Design (15 Minutes)

- On October 4, Mobility staff released the <u>updated (80%) design proposal for Western Pearl Street</u>. At this meeting, PTAC members will review the latest designs and offer recommendations.
- The Western Pearl Street Reconstruction project aims to increase safety, improve accessibility, incorporate more sustainability, and create a more comfortable Pearl Street between Medford Street and McGrath Highway. PTAC last reviewed this project in June 2025 during the City's engagement period around concept design options.

Discussion on Community Path Safety Improvements (30 Minutes)

- In early September 2025, Mobility staff launched the <u>Community Path Safety Improvements</u> project to address safety concerns and conflicts at key intersections and the two Green Line station entrances on the Community Path. The project aims to implement near-term quick-build improvements and longer-term design options based on community feedback.
- At this meeting, Mobility staff will offer a brief presentation on <u>potential interventions for improved</u>

 <u>Community Path safety</u> to frame a discussion among PTAC members.
- All members of the Somerville community can <u>offer insights on the project</u> through a survey (in multiple languages) and online public input map until **October 21**.
