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#	Question	Answer
1.	Will the prevailing wage rates included in the IFB change in June?	No. Prevailing wage rates for ongoing contracts are updated once per year. If the contract is renewed for a second year, the City will provide an updated prevailing wage rate sheet with the renewal documents.
2.	Are the estimated hours on the bid form intended to cover work under this contract at all locations?	Yes.
3.	How will work be scheduled?	This contract is for on-call services. The DPW Commissioner or Designee may request service from the Contractor when DPW does not have the in-house capacity. The Contractor may be called to work on spring start-up, on-call repairs during the spring/summer/fall, and winterization.
4.	What is the expected response time for service calls?	24 to 48 hours. In an extreme emergency, DPW will try to address or triage in-house.
5.	We will need an introduction to the site the first time we work at each location.	DPW will assign personnel to show the Contractor where gates, shut-offs, etc. are located at each site.
