### City Update: Upcoming Changes to CT2 & 85 Bus Routes; Street Redesign Development Processes (65 Minutes)

- Mobility staff will present [changes the MBTA is making this April to bus routes CT2 and 85](#). All existing CT2 stops will be served by the new route 85.
- Mobility staff will present on the processes they use to develop designs for street reconstruction and quick-build projects. They'll discuss the various stakeholders involved in the design development process, which decisions are made based on standards versus community engagement, and other factors that shape street redesigns in Somerville.
