



Medford Open House and Virtual Public Meeting

The MBTA is seeking public feedback on 11 proposed bus service changes to amend the Bus Network Redesign (BNR), our bus service expansion plan. Join us at our virtual public meeting or open house to share feedback on the changes proposed in the Medford area.

The MBTA is proposing revisions to specific bus routes under the Bus Network Redesign (BNR) to allow us to continue to expand service, grow ridership, and make bus service accessible to more people.

The goal of these events is to share information and hear public feedback on the changes we propose and incorporate it into our decision-making process. We want to hear from riders about proposed changes to Routes 67, 80, 94, 96, and 350 throughout Medford, Cambridge, Somerville, and Arlington.

Join us for a formal presentation on **July 21 from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM** on **Zoom** or drop by our **open house at the Medford City Hall on July 30 between 5:30 PM and 7:30 PM** to chat with project staff. Due to the complexity of the Medford proposals, these meetings will give us the opportunity to have more in-depth conversations with you.

These meetings are a part of the public engagement process that will include several in-person meetings in various communities affected by and benefiting from proposed revisions.

We'll use your feedback to update the BNR plan to incorporate these proposals. If approved, service changes would be rolled out alongside other Better Bus Network changes as necessary resources – like bus operators, facilities, and infrastructure – are made available.

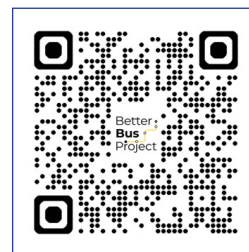
