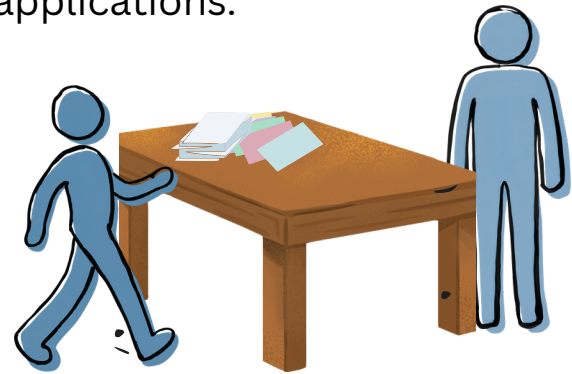
# Social Benefit Resource Fair
