

Partners HealthCare Workforce Development Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Training Program

Are you interested in launching a career as a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) at Spaulding Rehabilitation Network?

Partners HealthCare Workforce Development, in conjunction with the Academy for Healthcare Training, is offering a **free** CNA training program where our participants, upon successful graduation of the program, will earn dual Nursing Assistant and Home Health Aide certificates, receive placement assistance focusing on full-time CNA employment within the Spaulding Rehabilitation Network, and will be eligible to sit for the Massachusetts Nurse Aide Certification Exam (within 30 days of program completion) with exam fees covered by Partners HealthCare!

Program Information

The program is 7 weeks long and begins on February 20, 2018 and ends on April 6, 2018. The program includes both classroom-based instruction and a hands-on clinical experience at a skilled nursing facility, all of which are easily accessible via MBTA (subway/bus passes will be provided). Our training consists of:

- Medical Terminology & Anatomy
- CPR/First Aid/AED
- Workplace Safety & Infection Control
- Vital Signs & Range of Motion Exercises
- On-Site Clinical Experience
- Stress Management Techniques
- Computer Literacy Skills
- Customer Service and Problem Solving in Health Care
- Time Management & Multi-Tasking in Health Care
- Introduction to the Partners HealthCare Workplace Values
- Preparation and Fees for the CNA State Exam within 30 Days of Program Completion
- Interview & Resume Preparation
- Placement Assistance

Eligibility Requirements

All Applicants Must:

- Be at least 18 years of age and have a High School Diploma or Equivalent (will be verified)
- Be eligible to work in the United States without sponsorship
- Be seeking full-time work and available to work beyond daytime hours, including some weekends and holidays
- Pass a computer-based assessment that evaluates reading comprehension and basic math skills
- Have some prior work experience (preferred)
- Must be able to speak, read, write, and understand the English language
- Provide four (4) references email addresses through our online reference checking process
- Be able to attend training Monday through Friday at multiple locations for the entire 7-week program
- Must be able to cope with the mental and emotional stress associated with caring for ill, disabled, and emotionally upset patients
- Able to lift, walk, and stand without restrictions
- Must be able to move intermittently throughout the work day
- Willing to work with patients and staff of all genders and ethnic backgrounds
- Successfully complete CORI screening (upon acceptance into program)
- Obtain occupational health clearance (upon acceptance into program)
- Not be a current employee of Partners HealthCare or any of our affiliates/member institutions
