REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON LICENSES AND PERMITS

The Committee on Licenses and Permits convened on March 15, 2006, with Chairman Bruce Desmond presiding and Committee Members Aldermen Robert Trane and Maryann Heuston also present and voting. Also present were Alderman Rebekah Gewirtz, George Landers from ISD, Mr. Christos Poutahidis and representatives of Enterprise Rent-a-Car.

The committee held a Public Hearing on the garage license application of Enterprise Rent-a-Car. Representatives of Enterprise spoke in favor of the license and said that the garage would be used for vehicle washing and vacuuming. Enterprise would like to renovate the building but can't because they are not the owners of the property. Attorneys for all parties are trying to negotiate an agreement that would be amenable to all concerned. Mr. Landers informed those present that guidelines, as specified by ISD, would have to be met prior to the license being issued. He also noted that vehicles are being cleaned on the street, which in turn is creating problems. Chairman Desmond said that he will keep the item in committee until all agreements and modifications are finalized.
