# UNION SQUARE WALKING TOUR

Edward Gordon, President of the New England Chapter of the Victorian Society in America, will lead this year's tour of the Union Square area. The walk meanders through residential streets with high-styled Victorian houses and more modest vernacular homes on Prospect Hill, before highlighting some vintage commercial buildings along Washington Street and Somerville Avenue. One brief interior house visit and discover what's brewing at the Bantam Cider Company. Then end the afternoon with a refreshing reception hosted by the Nu Café on Washington Street, not far from the upcoming stop on the Green Line Extension.
