Partners in Career and Workforce Development (PCWD) is a free 8-week employment and training program designed for individuals interested in entry-level employment within one of the Partners hospitals. This unpaid training program, located on the Massachusetts General Hospital campus, meets Monday - Friday from 9:00 am - 5:00 pm and includes 4-weeks of classroom instruction and a 4-week internship in a basic clerical or support staff position. Graduates receive job search support in Career Club until employment goals are reached. PCWD is a DTA, WIA, and section 30 approved program.

TO BE ELIGIBLE YOU MUST:

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Speak, write and understand English
- Pass Reading, Language and Computer assessments
- Have CORI clearance
- Have at least 1 full year of work experience with one employer
