MINUTES Thursday, July 14th, 2016 Third Floor Conference Room, City Hall

- Sports Authority will be closing in the Assembly Square Marketplace

3. Union Square Update:

Sunayana Thomas gave updates regarding Union Square redevelopment.

- The Planning Division of OSPCD submitted new zoning code today, July 14th
- Michael Glavin noted that the \$50 million contribution to the Green Line Extension is being worked out with the Board of Aldermen to make sure we have the right framework. Somerville is in a different situation from Cambridge, which is making a \$25 million contribution to the project.
