Pantries and School Markets (~\$390,000)

- Project SOUP pantry for the Somerville Homeless Coalition
 - local food pantry
- Elizabeth Peabody House
 - Local food pantry
- Food4All
 - Local food pantry
- Shepherd's Kitchen
 - Local food pantry
- School Markets / Food for Free
 - Monthly pop-up pantry operating at three Somerville public schools

Grocery support (\$285,000)

- Somerville Cambridge Elder Services
 - *Grocery cards for homebound seniors*
- Carrot Cards+, Food for Free
 - *Reloadable, monthly grocery cards for students*

Ready-Made meal support (\$150,000)

- Prepared, frozen meals
 - *For people with limited kitchen access*
- Restaurant Meal Voucher – East Somerville Main St.
 - *Meal vouchers to East Somerville restaurants for people experiencing food insecurity and with limited kitchen access.*
- Community Meal – Connexion
 - *Supporting the weekly hot meal in East Somerville – open to all.*
