Non-Critical Violation Enforcement

- 1. If during a routine inspection conducted at a food establishment, non-critical violations are found, the owner will be given 14 days to correct the non-critical violations noted on the official inspection report.
- 2. After 14 days if the non-critical violations cited on the official report have not been corrected a \$100.00 ticket per outstanding violation may be issued. The owner will be given an additional 7 days to correct the outstanding violations.
- 3. After 7 days if the non-critical violations are not corrected an additional \$100.00 ticket per outstanding violation may be issued.
- 4. If the establishment has any previously cited non-critical violations that have not been corrected during the time frame noted above they may be ordered to appear before the Board of Health.
