## Residential Parking Permit

**Cost: \$40.00 per vehicle**

**\$0.00** If vehicle's Primary Driver is 65+ or primary driver has valid HP placard or plates

**Duration:** Up to 12 months; city is divided into 8 renewal districts. Permits are available for sale three months prior to renewal.

**Hours:** Unlimited in residential permit parking areas, unless otherwise posted.

**Location:** Citywide in residential permit parking areas.

### FAQ

#### Who is eligible?

- Somerville residents with vehicles registered and primary garaging code is Somerville.
- Also see [military parking permit](#) and/or [handicapped parking permit](#) information, if applicable.

#### What information is required?

- [Proof of residency](#) (see proof of residency page for more information)
- Commercial vehicles require additional documentation.

#### How do you apply?

- Applicants and renewals may hand deliver or mail completed application and copies of all needed documentation and payment to Parking Office at 133 Holland Street.
- Applicants and renewals may order online at [www.parksomerville.com](http://www.parksomerville.com). First time online users will need to set up an account prior to ordering.
- All permits will be mailed to resident address only.

#### How long does the process take?

- Permits requested at window will be processed immediately.
- Permits requested by mail will be processed within 15 business days after receipt of paperwork and payment.
- Permits requested on web will be approved within 15 days. Once approved and payment is completed permit will be mailed within 30 days.
- Permits may be renewed up to three months prior to expiration.

#### Additional Questions?

- Residents purchasing new vehicles are eligible to transfer existing permit providing new vehicle is in same name and same plate or old plate is returned to RMV. Contact office.
