If accepted by a majority of the 333 Great River Road Ward One voters, the special legislation would repeal the current charter and would Candidate for Re-election adopt Chapter 31 of the Acts of 2025, creating a new charter for the city. SCOTT ISTVAN The charter is the city's governing document. The current charter was 10 Austin Street first approved by the Commonwealth as a special act and was accepted Ward One by Somerville voters in 1899. It has been amended by additional special acts over time. The proposed charter establishes the city's structure, JONATHAN LINK 5 Bigelow Street organization and operations, including the city's executive and legislative Ward Three branches. The proposed charter maintains the existing form of government, retaining the executive and legislative branches and the JACK PERENICK existing composition of the city council and school committee. City 485 Foley Street Ward One councilors, school committee members and the mayor would continue to serve two-year terms. The proposed charter establishes a timeframe by **HOLLY SIMIONE** which the city council must vote to confirm certain appointments of the 14 Oakland Avenue mayor. The proposed charter requires an annual independent outside Ward Four audit and authorizes the city council to expand the scope of the audit to MARIANNE WALLES include a particular department, division, or program. The proposed 46 Fremont Street charter specifies the annual operating budget must be submitted by May Ward Four 30 of each year and requires public hearings and joint meetings of the city council and the school committee. The proposed charter also **BEN WHEELER** authorizes the city council to secure advisory legal counsel and to 16 Lee Street Ward Four employ staff.
