## Highlights of 2025-2026 season

- Caseworkers available on site
- ADA accessibility modifications
- Increased security presence
- Sleeping area expanded to 45 cots
- Increased collaboration with other local warming centers

## Quick stats

- Number of meals served - 12,650 meals
- Number of pets - 0-3 pets per night; cats and dogs

## Average number of clients per night

- December - 32 clients per night
- January - 50 clients per night
- February - 58 clients per night
- March - 58 clients per night
- April - 59 clients per night
- Highest number of clients in one night - 68 clients on Feb. 23rd

## Weather during season

- Over 62" of snow; snowiest winter we've had since 2015.
- From December through end of March, overnight temperatures averaged well under freezing at approximately 25° per night, -10° degrees with wind chill.
