HOW GOD PREPARED A DWELLING PLACE (A BODY) FOR HIS CHRIST

We are reading today in the Book of Genesis, Chapters One and Two. In last week's message, *How God Shares His Creative Power with His Creation*, we showed how God shared His creative power with us and how we too are creators in our realm and in the way that God allows us to create. He gave us a mind, and the mind is a beautiful thing, for the mind can think, create; and He gave us hands to create what our mind thinks. And He just blesses us in so many ways.

So last week's message laid out a thought pattern, and we want to take a furtherance of that thought today and title it, *How God Prepared a Dwelling Place (a Body) for His Christ*. And we want to look way back in the Book of Genesis, for Genesis is the seed chapter that tells us where and how God began creating everything. It is a wonderful book, especially the first few chapters because they show how God started His creation and what was back in the beginning.

One of the things that I want us to notice today is the similarities of the way God created Adam and Eve and compare that with the way He created His Son Jesus Christ and His Son's Wife. We want to see how Christ came into God's only begotten Son's Wife and also see how He created a body for Her. It all began with the message that Paul preached, which created the espoused virgin. And that creation has come into perfection with this message of the last trump of God that is now being preached, for this last trumpet message has created the Wife of the Lamb in glorified flesh and bones. So before we read in the Book of Genesis to get the thought pattern of God, let us pray.

Heavenly Father, we come praising you and thanking you for the way that you are moving in this moment in revealing your Word and how that you have made us part of you; and, Lord, you are revealing more and more how you have made us part of you. All the attributes that you have, you began to spread them out to the human family; Lord, you allotted certain attributes so that we could be creators too. Your commandment to Adam and Eve was to multiply and replenish the earth and subdue it, and you gave them that ability; and we thank you for it, for that ability is passed down to us in different ways. Lord, I pray that you will help us today with this message and bless and anoint us that we may say words that will benefit and help your people, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

So we are reading in Genesis, Chapter One, starting with Verse 26. "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion..." See, God gave mankind certain power, making them able to do certain things. Take for instance, in the land of Israel, there are botanical gardens and other beautiful places, which is mindboggling just how beautiful they were created. Well, that is what God did; He put that within mankind and gave them that creative power to fashion His creation and bring something beautiful into existence.

Again, Verse 26, "And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth." Verse 27, "So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them." Notice, it was just one being here—'male and female created He them.' (And I will show you later on how God separated this out.) Verse 28, "And God blessed them, and God said unto them (This is before a physical body was ever created. Sometimes we wonder how we know things oftentimes before they happen. But see, before the foundation of the world, before Adam and Eve was ever created, God put certain things in their spirit.), Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that

moveth upon the earth." God put this within the spirit of man before He ever created man.

Notice, some time went by between these verses of Genesis 1:26-27 and the verse that we will be reading next, which is Genesis 2:7. So here, Adam and Eve were already created in the spirit. And then God saw that everything He had made was good, and then God rested from all His work of creating. And then it says, "And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul." Here, God formed the physical body of man. First, He created them in the spirit, and then He formed the physical body for the man. But as of yet, there is no woman; she was here, but only in the spirit of Adam. And as we go further into this thought, we will see that God brings forth from His creation by also forming a woman with flesh and bones.

Here in Genesis, Chapter 2, is the beginning of God's creation of the human family as we know it. He created His son Adam first, and he was the *created* son of God, but not the *begotten* Son of God as Jesus was. And after Adam had been here for quite some time (and we do not know how long; it could have been many years, we do not know, but that is not the important part here since God did not reveal this in the Word), it says here in Verse 18, "And the Lord God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him an help meet for him." This would be a furtherance of God's creation sometime after Adam was created. And all of this will be important as we get on into the message today.

Notice, God saw that Adam was lonely, and He said, "It is not good for man to be alone." And He makes a promise, "I will make an help meet for him." Then He leaves it there and goes on creating in Verses 19-20, "And out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field, and every fowl of the air; and brought them unto Adam to see what he would call them: and whatsoever Adam called every living creature, that was the name thereof. (There is no

Eve yet.) And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; (Now watch.) but for Adam (See, there was a length of time between Adam being created and Eve being created; and He speaks of it again.) there was not found an help meet for him." So Adam became lonely, and God saw a need—"It is not good for man to be alone." All the animals that God made, He saw that it was good. And when He saw that it was good, He created and brought them to Adam to see what Adam would call them. He gave Adam that privilege and that authority. Adam was not put here in the earth to not know anything; he was a worker with God. God created, and Adam named. God told Adam, "You take dominion over the earth now. I am putting this in your hands." And the spirit of Eve was in Adam all this time, the feminine attributes that were to be manifested and come forth in a body of her own. And to create a body for Eve, He took a rib from the side of Adam.

Now we are going to begin to bring all this over to where God created His Son Jesus Christ and also how He created His Son's Wife. Verses 21-24 says, "And the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon Adam, and he slept: and he took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh instead thereof; And the rib, which the Lord God had taken from man, made he a woman, and brought her unto the man. And Adam said (and this is the same thing that Paul prophesied in the Book of Ephesians 5:30-32, so we will see how it all fits so perfectly together as we go along in this message), This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh: she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man. Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh." I want you to notice that when God created Eve, He took a rib from Adam. She was not directly taken from the dust of the earth as Adam was, but she was from Adam. And the creation of the espoused virgin was not taken directly from the literal Jesus Christ but was created from the spiritual rib (which was the Word, the message that Paul preached) that was taken from the spiritual side of Jesus Christ, who is from the creative Word that was with the Father in the beginning.

So now we are looking at espousal and marriage from the standpoint of the New Testament, which shows a similar creation to Adam and Eve. This began to take place by Paul's sounding of the trumpet. The first sounding of the trumpet was to create the virgin to be married to the Lord Jesus Christ, but because the espoused virgin fell from the Word, the marriage could not take place until the last sounding of the trumpet in our day.

Last week's message brought a good foundation for this message, for we showed how God shares His creative power with His creation. And when God began His creation of a Wife for His Son Jesus Christ, He gave Paul creative power; and Paul created by his message, by calling out a people who he espoused as a chaste virgin to the Lord Jesus Christ. So he preached a specific gospel for a specific people; that is all he had to dobring the message for this purpose of God-and there was something in the people that responded to that Word, and they could not help themselves. They heard Paul's message and rallied to it. There were some Orthodox Jews, which means they were followers of Moses, who were predestinated to be part of the espoused virgin, who left their Orthodox religion and came and accepted the message that Paul was preaching. And then from the Gentile world, which were called heathens, there also came a people. And as Paul preached what he called 'my gospel,' his message created a group of people, the virgin, and he espoused them to the Lord Jesus Christ to become the Wife of the Lamb. So he created a new group, and that new group consisted of both Jews and Gentiles that God had brought together in a spiritual realm. They were baptized into the body of Christ by his espousal message. And Paul said, "Ye are the body of Christ," and they were to be married to the Lord Jesus Christ, becoming bone of His bones and flesh of His flesh. But it stopped short of that because they fell away from the simplicity of Paul's message. So he had to put them under a survival law for seven church ages, until Christ Jesus came to earth (shown in the form of the Mighty Angel in Revelation, Chapter 10) and brought us the little book for the marriage of the Lamb. And we took the little book and ate it up and became the Wife of the Lamb, thus fulfilling that scripture in Ephesians 5:30-32.

That is why I wanted to read that in Genesis to show that Eve was created from the rib of Adam, and when Adam woke up out of his sleep, he said, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh." Exactly, perfectly the same thing Paul said as it relates to the Wife of the Lamb. So all these things are very important as we see that Christ the Wife has been taken from the spiritual side of the Lord Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, and created glorified flesh and bones.

In the Book of John 1:1, the Apostle John gives witness to us about the Word that was *with* the Father, for he said, "In the beginning was the Word. And the Word was *with* God. And the Word was God." Then John goes on and tells more about the Word, for he says in Verse 14, "And the Word was made flesh." Now I want you to notice that, the Word became flesh. And the Word we are speaking of today is glorified flesh and bones. That is why this last trump of God message is the message of the glorified flesh and bones. It is a message sent of the Lord, and it is glorifying the living as well as those departed saints who are part of the Wife that Christ Jesus brought back with Him when He came.

Notice Paul's prophetic Word in 1 Corinthians 15:51-52; it is Word that did not come alive in Paul's day, but it has now come alive in the sounding of this last trump of God message that is going to all nations as a witness of the creative power of God. Paul said in his day, "If the trumpet gives an uncertain sound, if this is uncertain, then who is going to be prepared?" We cannot

prepare if it is a guessing game—guessing at this and guessing at that. And we cannot prepare if the sound of it does not strike the music sheet just right. And this music sheet is not necessarily a written music sheet, it is not written in so many words, but it is the music sheet within us, and when we hear the music (the last trump of God sounding), it seems we have heard it before, for it was put in us before the foundation of the world.

So I want you to notice, when God created Adam and Eve, He created them first in the spirit, and He put within them all the things they were to do; and that was before He ever created their fleshly bodies; for God said before He created the bodies of Adam and Eve—'Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.' And then God created fleshly bodies for them so that they could go forth and do what He had put in them to do.

Now that we have established this thought, let us go to the Book of Matthew, Chapter 4, to show the Son of God, the Lord Jesus Christ; and this was after He was baptized of John the Baptist and the fullness of Christ came into Him. Here it says that He was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil for forty days and nights. And each time, whatever the devil threw at Him, He overcame. Then His ministry began, and He went forth in the power of the fullness of Christ. And He was tested all the way through by those of that religious system that Satan had embedded himself in. But shown in Matthew, Chapter 26, the final test was there in the Garden of Gethsemane at the foot of the Mount of Olives where He prayed and His sweat became as great drops of blood. And when He was going to have to give His life, God, in order to make the trial real, gave Him a choice. God said, "You do not have to go through with this, you can call twelve legions of angels and save yourself and destroy these men that seek your life, or you can give your life as the Lamb of God." And Jesus prayed there in the garden, saying, "Father, if it be thy will, let this cup pass from me." And when He had prayed a third time, He said, "Not my will, but thine be done. For this purpose came I into the world." See, Jesus did not have to die, for He had overcome death there in the garden; for there God gave Him a choice of whether to live and let all the rest of God's family die or to die as a sacrifice for the sins of all God's predestinated seed that they may have eternal life. So His choice was that He would willingly lay down His life for His Wife and all the other children of God. And then He said this (and I love this scripture), "If I do not do this, how else can the scripture be fulfilled?" And all through His ministry, many things that He did, it was said, "This He did that the scripture might be fulfilled."

So we see that God tries everyone that goes into eternity. There is no end to eternity; and everyone there will be there because they were tried and tested. Even the natural people, those that will be caretakers of the earth in eternity, will be tested at the end of the millennial reign and will overcome the devil before going forward into eternity.

God has sent forth this last trump of God message, which has made clear all the things that God has ordained for the Wife of the Lamb. He sent it forth, and it is the creative message of glorified flesh and bones; and there is no other message that does this. There is just one. There is one Wife, who has one message, and it is already in us; all we had to do was hear it and things began to click and come together, and we were never the same again. And we cannot be deceived nor tossed to and fro because we were that to begin with; for we were predestinated in Him before the foundation of the world. Yes, we were there then, in God's mind, so our salvation is very much assured, and not only our salvation but our position as the Wife of the Lamb. Because of what Jesus Christ did in the garden, we do not have to die, because we were in Him as part of this last trumpet message to receive this endowment along with those members that God took before this trumpet began to sound. Because of the fall of the virgin, they went by the way of the grave; but because they were part of the Wife, Christ Jesus brought them back to earth to hear this message of glorified flesh and bones. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-17, and 1 Corinthians 15:51-57)

So this is what happened: Our Lord Jesus Christ came and lived here for about thirty years and was known as Jesus the carpenter. He was not Jesus Christ then; He was Jesus the carpenter. Then at about the age of thirty, the fullness of Christ came into Him, and the Bible says, "He received the Spirit without measure." That means the Spirit, which is both masculine and feminine came into Jesus, and He became Jesus Christ. And then, of course, He went forth with a message; and the Spirit was seen as Jesus Christ walked upon this earth, and the plan of God began to unfold as He went about doing the will of God.

In the Book of Romans 15:8, it says that Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made unto the (Jewish) fathers. So He was sent to the nation of Israel. And in the Book of Matthew, Chapter 10, He commanded His apostles, saying, "Go not into the way of the Gentiles, and into any city of the Samaritans enter ye not: but go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." And even after He was crucified and resurrected and came back in the form of the Holy Ghost, the apostles stayed with that saying of 'go only to the house of Israel;' because in the Book of Acts 11:19, which was after Pentecost, the Bible says, "They went everywhere preaching the gospel to none but the Jews only."

Notice, they preached only to the Jews, even after Peter went and opened the gospel door to the Gentiles shown in Acts, Chapter 10. Peter was the only one that could open the gospel door to them, for he had been given the keys to the Kingdom. So he not only opened the door to the Jews but also to the Gentiles. And while all that was going on, God had already struck Paul down on his way to Damascus by a light that was brighter than the sun, and the Lord Jesus revealed Himself to

him, and Paul took that rib out of the spiritual side of the Lord Jesus Christ, which was a message to begin the creation of a Wife for God's Son. And this was like what God said in Genesis 2:18, "It is not good for man to be alone. I will create a wife for him; I will make him a help meet." Well, the time had come for God to begin to create a helpmeet for the Lord Jesus Christ, to begin to create a permanent dwelling place for the feminine part of Christ. So He raised up Paul to begin the creative message that began to do this. And his message created a people, a virgin to the Lord Jesus Christ, to be married to Him. No, the marriage did not take place then, but it has now by the sounding of this last trumpet. And the Wife of the Lamb is the permanent dwelling place of Christ for the feminine attributes to manifest through, with Jesus being the King and She being the Queen. And God made Her part of the Godhead because She was taken from and is part of the Lord Jesus Christ. And Paul waxed bold and said, "We are bone of His bones and flesh of His flesh." So that put us in the category separate from any other group of Christians. Now that does not take away from any other of God's workings with any of His redeemed people, but it means we are the Wife of the Lamb, a new order of saints, glorified flesh and bones.

In Revelation, Chapter 10, the Mighty Angel came to earth and said that there should be time no longer. In other words, time was no longer for the church ages. And then we went into a different realm of not being the virgin but being the married Wife, where the Wife of the Lamb has stepped forth and has met death head-on and has overcome it. For we have received the revelation of 'we which are alive and have remained are not going to die, but we are going to be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye;' and Jesus Christ made this possible and sealed this truth forever by going to the garden and dying on the cross. So our time of the twinkling of an eye is taking place, as the creative power of God is in this last trump of God message.

When Paul was preaching his creative message, did it change the Jews' nationality? Outwardly, it did not. Or the Gentiles? Outwardly, it did not. So there were Jews and there were Gentiles, but when they heard Paul's message, all of that began to fade into the background. They fell so in love with the Lord Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, that they said, "This is for me!" And Paul's message actually created a group of people that he called *the body of Christ* in 1 Corinthians, Chapter 12.

Notice, Paul tells us about being baptized into the body of Christ. Yes, the body of Christ was in the making in the days of Paul, but it was only in the spiritual realm, not in the physical realm. That message that Paul preached baptized them into the spiritual body of Christ. But there was another part of the Word, which was the glorified flesh and bones that was to come, that they did not receive. But they are receiving it now, for there is a message that has come on the scene that has created glorified flesh and bones upon those souls that Christ brought back to this earth (1 Thessalonians 4:14), while it is changing our mortal bodies into that of glorification also. And that is what you are hearing now.

Notice, when Paul preached the Word of God, he said, "By one Spirit you are baptized into one body." Let us read 1 Corinthians, Chapter 12, starting with Verses 12-14. It says, "For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. (Now watch what he is getting to.) For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, (I love this.) whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit. For the body is not one member, but many." I want you to watch that—a manymember body. That is what it is; a group of people. It is a special group. And this special group hears a message, and they cannot help being drawn to it when they hear it. It is just like a magnet drawing metal shavings; it just draws them to it, and everything else seems pale to the sight of this. Yes, there are other things

that are of God, they are just not *our* part of the program of God. They are not *our* part of the plan of God because our part is the Wife of His Son—bone of His bones and flesh of His flesh. We were created out of His rib, for that Spirit that was in the Lord Jesus Christ came into this many-member body as we were baptized into this last trump of God message of glorified flesh and bones and have become Christ the Wife of the Lamb.

Now let us read Verse 27. "Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular." Now "we are the body of Christ." We are the body; we are the resting place; we are the dwelling place that God created for Christ. That is the finality of it. There is the Son as the 'He part' of Christ, who is the carrier of the masculine attributes. But then there is His Wife as the 'She part' of Christ, who is the carrier of the feminine attributes, and they are manifested in the body of Christ, which has taken on glorified flesh and bones in this moment of the twinkling of an eye. It is a special group of people. And John was looking through the eyes of God there in Revelation 19:7-8, and he said, "Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His Wife hath made Herself ready; and to Her was granted..." Notice, "and to Her was granted that She should be clothed in fine linen, clean and white, for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." And that was what Paul was looking at, for he said in the Book of Philippians 3:14, "I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus." That is the marriage, which makes us the Wife of the Lamb. But before the marriage could be accomplished, the virgin fell away from this creative Word, and the marriage was postponed until the last trumpet sounded, which has brought to completion the marriage. So now Revelation 19:7-8 has become living Word in glorified flesh and bones.

As said earlier, this last trump of God message is the creative message that was sent of the Lord, which is creating glorified flesh and bones upon not only those of us who are alive in our mortal bodies but also upon the spirits (souls) of the Wife saints that died from Paul's day all the way through the church ages, who are now back on earth. They came back in Revelation, Chapter 10, when Christ Jesus came back, for He brought them with Him. In 1 Thessalonians 4:14, it is said, "When He comes, God will send those spirits with Him." Why? Because they needed to hear this trumpet sound, they needed to hear this message, which picked up where Paul's trumpet stopped sounding. There is no gap between it; it is a seamless transition. It transitioned from the sounding of Paul's message into *this* message that is fulfilling all that Paul prophesied would be here. And it has even gone beyond *that*; for the things that God is giving us now are present-tense Word that is just for us in this moment of the twinkling of an eye. Glory to God! Hallelujah!

In the days of Paul, he said, "Ye are the body of Christ." But it was the body of Christ without flesh and bones. It was the mystical body, a spiritual body. They heard the Word and they came to it; but this message has brought it further than that, for it has created glorified flesh and bones on those souls. You say, "How could that be, Brother Ben?" It is like when the angel spoke to Mary and said to her, "You shall have a child." That was Word becoming flesh and bones. It was Word that God sent forth, and it was creative Word; and God has allowed us to be part of His creation as the manifestation of that Word of glorified flesh and bones is solidified in us as the Wife of the Lamb.

Others that are God's predestinated seed are part of His creation, but they are created from another message, for they are not bone of our Lord Jesus Christ's bones and flesh of His flesh as His Wife is. So they will receive their glorified bodies at the physical coming of the Lord Jesus Christ for the millennial reign. (Revelation 19:11-16) But first, *this message* creates a body of glorified flesh and bones for the Wife of the Lamb, both the Wife saints who are alive and have remained and also those who have gone on.

Notice, the spiritual body was already in existence, but He has created glorified flesh and bones upon those souls that He brought with Him. Paul saw these souls and told us about them in the Book of 2 Corinthians, Chapter 5, saying, "We have a building of God reserved in heaven," which were the souls of those that had gone on. But here came a message creating glorified flesh and bones upon them when they were brought to earth. They had to be brought to earth to hear this trumpet message. And they are here today rejoicing and shouting and praising God as they along with us are being glorified day by day during this moment of the twinkling of an eye.

So in 1 Corinthians 12:27, Paul wrote, "Now ye are the body of Christ and members in particular." Then the espoused virgin fell away, and the marriage was put on hold; and what God's Word said would be, did not come to pass then. But it is now coming to pass with this last trump of God message that picked up where Paul's message stopped. And now the body that was spoken of is seen here. And the Word did not say that we type out the body, but it says, 'we are the body of Christ.' And that spiritual body of Christ of Paul's day is now created glorified flesh and bones; they have joined with us who also have taken on glorified flesh and bones, and together we will be caught up to meet the Lord in the air.

So our Lord Jesus Christ is now revealing and putting emphasis on us, His Christ Wife. See, we are the body of Christ, members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones, and He gave us the Christ part of His name. And just like Adam said about his wife Eve, now the Lord Jesus can say about His Wife, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh and Spirit of my Spirit; She is part of me. She is my Wife. She is my help meet." And help meet means compatible, suitable. The Lamb has a beautiful Wife, and we are Christ the Wife. And we express those feminine attributes that were brought to earth by Christ Jesus who was expressing Himself as the Mighty Angel, and we

have taken on Christ by eating up the little book that was for the changing of our mortal body.

So Adam was the first son, the created son, but Jesus was the begotten Son. These same words of 'bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh' was spoken by Paul as he laid in the prophetic part of the Word for us to fulfill in this day. And here it is, being fulfilled! Hallelujah! Here is the Wife; and in us is the final resting place or dwelling place of Christ. And we are bearing our fruits. See, the Wife is the one that bears the fruit. Eve was to bear Adam's fruit in her day. That is why God said to be fruitful and multiply and replenish the earth. That is why the fruits of the Lord are among us. The gifts of the Lord are among us. We are the Wife of the Lamb, the final resting place of Christ.

So now not only the picture of Adam and Eve is clearly seen, but also the picture of our Lord Jesus Christ the Lamb of God and His Christ Wife is clearly seen, for She is now showing forth the feminine attributes that were put in Her before the foundation of the world. That is why we love Him. That is why we call Him Savior, Lord, Husband, and King, and we cannot heap enough praise upon Him. And we are His helpmeet (not helpmate); we are compatible with Him because this last trump of God message made us compatible with Him. It brought the mind of Christ to us, and it has created a people from all walks of life. For when we heard this trumpet sound, we knew we were part of it because we were ordained to be that before the foundation of the world—the Wife of the Lamb. So everything else fled away as we heard this message of marriage and were sold on it one hundred percent, and we cannot be tossed to and fro.

Let me say again, in the days of Paul, he took a rib (a message) out of the spiritual side of Jesus Christ as God gave him His creative power to begin the creation of a Wife for His Son. So Paul created in his day the espoused virgin; and now by this message we are created the Wife of the Lamb in glorified flesh
