THE DAY OF HE, THE HOLY GHOST, AND THE DAY OF SHE, THE WIFE OF THE LAMB

Today I want to take a thought and title it, *The Day of He, the Holy Ghost, and the Day of She, the Wife of the Lamb*; and we want to look to the Lord knowing that He will bless us and help us. Jesus Christ said to His disciples when He was here, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now." But we are now in the moment of the twinkling of an eye, and there is not a long drawn out time for the Wife of the Lamb to be manifested, so She is being manifested now in a special way; and we are seeing it daily.

We are going to be reading from the Book of John, Chapter 16, Verses 7-15, in order to bring in He, the Holy Ghost. We will also be showing that after the Word and God's Spirit were rejected by the religious world (as Paul prophesied about in the Book of 2 Thessalonians 2:3-12), He, the Holy Ghost, would be taken out of the way. And now that this has happened, it opened the door for Christ the Wife of the Lamb to come forth. And now the fullness of Christ is being manifested through the Wife of the Lamb. But what happened to the Holy Ghost when He was taken out of the way? He could no longer have an influence on the way this religious world would go, seeing they had rejected both the Word and the Spirit. So for the worldly religious people, the Holy Ghost ceased to deal with them. Yet, He continued to deal with the predestinated seed of God to prepare them for the dreadful time ahead, as the antichrist now has free reign over this religious world with his spirit of iniquity opening the way for the man of sin to reveal himself as we are seeing in this last day.

Now that the fullness of Christ has come forth (both the He part in the Lord Jesus Christ along with the She part in the Wife of the Lamb), the joy of the Lord has been given in a great and mighty way. Prior to this, the He part of Christ was manifested more on the masculine level before the falling away took place that Paul spoke of. But now our Lord Jesus Christ has a Wife, and His Wife has become part of the Godhead. Now let us pray.

Heavenly Father, it is in the name of Jesus Christ that we come to you once again, the name that is above every name, and the name that has kept us safe all through time until now. Lord, we appreciate you, and we pray that you will anoint us to say words today that will be a blessing and will benefit the Wife of the Lamb and others that you have ordained to benefit by it. Amen.

So our first reading today is concerning He the Holy Ghost. In times gone by, I would read, "He the Holy Ghost," and I would wonder why it would say He, because the Holy Ghost was not a person. The Holy Ghost was Spirit. So over the years I would just read it and kind of leave it how it was written without commenting a whole lot on it. John spoke of He, the Holy Ghost, in John, Chapter 16, and then he spoke of *She*, the Wife of the Lamb, in the Book of Revelation, Chapter 22, saying, "She bears Her fruit (the tree of life bears Her fruit)." We have a book called, The She Part of Christ is the Wife of the Lamb in all Her Glory, and people notice immediately when they pick up the book that it says, "The She Part of Christ." And some begin to scratch their heads, thinking, "I have never heard anything like 'the She part of Christ.'" Well, it was not to be revealed until now because prior to this it could not be received in its fullness.

A couple of weeks ago I preached the message, God Worketh All Things After the Counsel of His Own Will, where I brought in about the antichrist spirit and how that he has come and taken over the religious system and also the political system, which is just a different arm of it. But prior to this happening, God was holding back this antichrist spirit by the Holy Ghost which held it in check, for certain things could not go completely off course until they rejected His Word, the Bible. But when they rejected God's Word, then He, the Holy Ghost, was taken out of the way as the religious world turned their backs on both God's spiritual law and moral (or natural law). Notice that He. Well, that is the Holy Ghost; He was taken out of the way so that the antichrist could come and do what the people wanted anyway. They do not want the real thing. They want something that they can manipulate, to work it as they want to work it. But God's ways will always prevail.

Recently, I had a dream concerning a situation; and in the dream, there were a couple of people who were saying to me, "Ben, we want to take your picture." Well, I am not too fond of having my picture taken, even though there are a lot of pictures of me out there. But I said, "Okay." And then they said, "We need to fix your hair a little bit," and one of them pulled my hair down in front some. I did not know exactly how it looked until I walked by a mirror and I seen that it was pulled down over my forehead. So I immediately said, "No, I am not going to get my picture taken with my hair down like that." Then I went and got my hair combed back again because I did not want to have my picture taken with my hair over my forehead. They did not want to cut my hair, but they just wanted to change it

a little bit. See, they did not want to come out and say I was wrong because that would be 'cutting my hair,' but they wanted to bring in something that would change it a little bit. Just a few words can mean a lot. When you change one thing, it can change the whole meaning of a subject. So I would not go along with it. So let it be known that you cannot change this Word; and you cannot change a person that is *in* this Word. So we praise God for His keeping power and for being the keeper of His Word.

Now as promised earlier, let us begin reading in John, Chapter 16, and we are going to deal first with *He*, the Holy Ghost. And I want you to notice how many times it says *He* in this chapter. And we are not going to read all of the places because we would not get through today; and besides, this message is ongoing, with things that have been hid since the foundation of the world. But now it is not like it was in that day when Jesus Christ said to His disciples, "You are not quite ready for this revelation," because the Wife of the Lamb has come into Her moment of the twinkling of an eye, and She *is* ready for all that Jesus Christ has for Her, and She will receive with great joy.

Verse 7 says, (this is Jesus speaking), "Nevertheless I tell you the truth (and He always did that); It is expedient (or necessary) for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you." Verse 8, "And when he (notice, you have him in Verse 7 and he in Verse 8) is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment." Verses 9-11, "Of sin, because they believe not on me; Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged." And that is why He began to show things that would be prevalent as He went away.

Notice this, Jesus Christ physically went away, but that *He* (the Holy Ghost that was in Him) came right back and began to do the things that Jesus Christ would have done if He was still here physically.

We have spoken often, especially in recent times, about the masculine part of the Christ Spirit. And it is so beautiful as we pick it up in the Book of Genesis, Chapter One, where God begins to create man. There it tells us that God created man in His own image, in the image of God created He him; male and female created He them. So Adam was created only in the spirit at first; then God formed a body, which was made from the dust of the earth, and He put Adam into it. Then God formed the animals and so on and brought them to Adam to see what he would name them, and whatever he said, that is the way it was; so there was the *he* part speaking forth. But there was still no *she* part that was visible. But the she part was there in Adam, and it was in God from the beginning because God has both masculine and feminine attributes. God can be as real to a female just as much as He can be to a male. He can be known to a woman just as much as He can be known to a man. God is always Spirit. And Christ is the same way. And God deals with man through His Christ, which is the part of God that deals with mankind.

When God created man, He made man with the spirit of male and female. This was the same pattern God used starting out with the Christ Spirit which had both the masculine and feminine attributes within it. Therefore, He first created Adam with both masculine and feminine attributes. And that is what He did with Jesus Christ also. He created the male attributes first and then the female attributes. And then God rested from all His work. Then

later the Lord God formed a body for the man from the dust of the earth. And after a while, Adam became lonely and wanted a mate. So God put Adam to sleep and took a rib from Adam, and with the rib He formed Eve, Adam's Wife. Likewise, I am so glad that Jesus Christ became lonely for that 'natural glorified flesh and bones female She part that God had ordained for Him, which He began to create through Paul's message, a virgin that he espoused to be married; for later John looked through the eyes of God to our day and he saw us, the married Wife, clothed in fine linen, clean and white. And 'fine linen, clean and white' does not represent a man's clothing. That is the feminine part. Where is the masculine part? It is in Christ Jesus; because when the Holy Ghost lifted, it did not just go away, it is still in Jesus the Christ, and He can still use the Holy Ghost as He pleases; for the Holy Ghost is still within God's people. But the main thing is the Holy Ghost kept that antichrist spirit in check so that it could not come in its fullness and do its damage until the world came to its lowest level and rejected the Word of God.

In the Book of Luke, Chapter 22, Jesus went to the Garden of Gethsemane (at the foot of the Mount of Olives) to pray, for the time of His crucifixion had drawn neigh. And here came Judas (one of the twelve disciples, who betrayed Him) along with the chief priests and the captains of the temple and the elders to take Him. And Jesus said unto them, "Be ye come out as against a thief with swords and staves? When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me: **but this is your hour, and the power of darkness.**" See, until it was time for Jesus Christ to be taken out of the way, they could not go forth and do many of the things they did because He was

there doing miracles and fulfilling the work that God had given Him to do. But when Jesus Christ was taken out of the way, *that* opened the door for the antichrist to do his evil work. And although the antichrist thought he won, it was instead a great defeat.

Now let us look at the first leg of the coming of Christ as the Holy Ghost, which was on the day of Pentecost where a great revival had broken forth as the apostles went forth preaching the gospel, for God was bearing them witness with great signs and wonders. We see the beginning of this in the Book of Acts, Chapters 3-4, when Peter and John were on their way to the temple, and Peter by the power of God healed a man that was brought each day to the gate of the temple for alms, who had been lame from his mother's womb, and the man went forth leaping and praising God. The people that were there saw the man walking and praising God, and they knew that he was the man that had sat for alms at the gate of the temple called Beautiful, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened unto him. And Peter saw this and began to preach to them, telling them that it was the Holy One, Jesus Christ the Son of God, whom they had crucified that had healed the man. And then Peter said, "Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord." And as Peter and John spoke unto the people, the priests and the captain of the temple and the Sadducees came upon them, being grieved that they taught the people and preached through Jesus the resurrection from the dead. See, the chief priest wanted to get rid of the apostles. The priests and the elders knew that a notable miracle had been done because there stood the lame man that had been healed, so they could not deny it. So in hopes that it would not spread any further among the people, they threatened and commanded the apostles henceforth not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Jesus. But the apostles did not listen to them, but went forth with great power preaching and teaching Jesus Christ and Him resurrected. Well, that is what happened as Jesus Christ moved in these men through the Holy Ghost. So the Lord Jesus was manifesting Himself through *He* the Holy Ghost. And that was the main attribute (the masculine attribute) shining forth first. Notice, with Adam and Eve, the male came first. God created Adam first and then Eve. And here God was working through His only begotten Son in the form of the Holy Ghost.

So God created the male, Jesus, first; and He lived here about thirty years before He received the fullness of Christ within Him. And this happened when He was baptized of John the Baptist in the Jordan River; for He received the Spirit without measure. This was God creating the Lord Jesus Christ in one fleshly person. And according to the Book of Romans 15:8, Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the truth of God to confirm the promises made unto the fathers. Notice, He was sent to the Jews, and eventually He is going to be the King of the Jews, and not only that, but the King of the earth. This will be in the millennium, where He will appoint those twelve apostles to serve there to be judges of the twelve tribes of Israel. And there will also be the Wife of the Lamb, the tree of life, who has all the feminine attributes. But right now, here in this moment of the twinkling of an eye, the Woman has come forth in preeminence. So here comes a Woman now, and John said, "It is the Wife of the Lamb, and She is clothed in fine linen, clean and white."

So the He part of Christ in the form of the Holy Ghost manifested Himself in a mighty way, and the She part of Christ basically had to take the backseat in many instances, and especially in the realm of the Jewish elders. All the elders were men; and the leadership rested there, and it still does. Likewise, the leadership in the body of Christ rests in the male part; but the whole body is called *She*, the Wife of the Lamb. Yes, there were twelve Jewish apostles, but God had an apostle laid back, which was the Apostle Paul, who had been kept secret in God's mind until it came time to begin the creation of the She part of Christ. And the creation that was started in Paul's day produced the espoused virgin, which has now become the Wife of the Lamb in our day.

So now Jesus Christ' main emphasis is on the Wife of the Lamb in this moment of the twinkling of an eye. We see this in the publishing of the books, audios, and videos on our website, which shows that God is moving in a great way. These messages are going forth, and they show the coming forth of the She part of Christ, the Wife of the Lamb. Prior to this time that we are now living in, the She part had not stepped out too much. But now She has stepped onto the scene. She is a small group of saints who are beginning to show the power of the She part of Christ, for She is married to the Lord Jesus Christ. We ate up the little book of Revelation, Chapter 10, and now all the feminine attributes are coming forth. And because we have the feminine attributes, we are looking to our Lord Jesus Christ, our Husband and King; and we love it when those masculine attributes step forth and show that our Husband the Lord Jesus Christ is still seeing to our spiritual needs. This makes the She part glad. We love what God is doing!

When Christ Jesus came back in the fullness of His Spirit in Revelation, Chapter 10, after the opening of the seven seals, He brought the little book back with Him, and we saw the sign of the Lord Jesus Christ right there. And following this, there was a marriage that took place by proxy as the male and female Spirits married together and that feminine part of Christ found its eternal home in the fleshly body of Christ here in the earth, who had already been looking to the Lord for its leadership. For, as the virgin who was waiting for the marriage, the leadership was recognized as coming from Her Husband, the Lord Jesus Christ, as it shined forth through His ministry that was ordained for Her security and joy. Remember here, back in God, back in Christ, back in Adam, and all the way through, it has always been male and female. And now in the end time they have manifested themselves, and we see this daily in both the written Word and also in the spoken Word.

When Jesus Christ was walking here in this earth, no one would look at Him as having feminine attributes also. And now no one would look at the Wife of the Lamb as having masculine attributes also. For She is the one that is dressed in fine linen, clean and white, and She knows how to dress too, which is typical of the ways of a woman. My wife cannot hardly resist buying a new tie for me, and she likes a certain feel to them. And when I get ready to get a suit or something, she will look and feel it to see if the material is of a good quality. See, when a woman buys cloth, she wants to feel it to see what kind of material it is. When they

go into a store, they will look at each row of cloth, then they will feel it with their hands and rub it against their face. And you will not normally find a man doing that. The fact is, not too many of us men buy cloth. But the point is, there is a difference! Because by this action, we do not see the masculine attributes, but we can see the feminine attributes showing forth.

So in the beginning of the creation of mankind, God gave Adam, His created son, a wife, and now He has given His only begotten Son a Wife. And now the completion of this has come to fruition. But I want to show you how the *He* part of Christ had to shine forth and push back everything that opposed to make a way for the *She* part of Christ to come on the scene. And with all confidence, She is believing and accepting Her role as the She part of Christ.

Throughout time, the Pentecostals were fighters, especially those that believed in the Holy Ghost and baptism in the name of Jesus Christ. They were not bashful about getting into an argument or debate about the gospel. But since the virgin has become Wife, She looks at it in a different way. She knows that by revelation God will give understanding, and until He does, it is useless to argue about it. So unless God gives it by revelation, it will not be received; so She does not fight about it but holds to the truth, and She is not tossed to and fro. Her Husband leads, and they rejoice together in the Lord. And that is the way it is in this day of She, the Wife of the Lamb.

Most mornings when my wife gets up, if she happens to get up before I do, I will hear her in the kitchen singing. Also at other times in the day, she can be heard singing all through the house. It is the joy of the Lord! Oftentimes, I meditate, and I am a little less vocal, but she is usually

vocally joyful! I said one time, "The man is the head of the house, but the woman is the heart of the house." There is a difference, so do not try to make those things the same; you are going to get into more trouble than you can get out of if you do. Just take it as God's Word says it, as God started it. You can read Genesis, Chapter One, starting with Verse 26, and see the real story on male and female and how God ordained His plan. It started in the spirit; but then He created Adam, and then later He created Eve, and He put those feminine attributes in her—and now God has a man and woman. And He brought Eve unto Adam, and Adam said, "This is now bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman because she was taken out of Man."

So just as the Holy Ghost was taken out of the man Jesus Christ, now the *She* part of Christ has been taken out of the man Christ Jesus and given to His Wife to manifest Herself because She is part of the Godhead, married to the Son of God. God is a Spirit, and He always manifests Himself as Spirit, while His Son Jesus Christ and His Wife are now both spiritual and physical.

In Revelation, Chapter 22, we see the throne of God and the Lamb, and then we find the Wife of the Lamb is right there as the tree of life. So we see that the masculine attributes that were in God found a body a permanent dwelling place in the Lord Jesus Christ. And then we find the feminine attributes found a permanent dwelling place in the Wife of the Lamb, and She is the tree of life and is called Her, 'She bears Her fruit.' But back before then, it was *He*; He was the tree of life walking around here. But now the *She* has been taken out of the He. And in eternity, there is God the Father, which is Spirit; there is the Son

Jesus Christ, which is glorified flesh and bones; and then there is His Wife, which is part of Him, and She is also glorified flesh and bones. And God honors the Wife of His Son and lets that river of life flow right through this group that is part of the Godhead. And on either side of the tree of life is the river of life, because it has to flow through, and there is where the life source comes from. God is honoring the Wife of His Son in this moment of the twinkling of an eye, for this is the moment for the Woman, the Wife of the Lamb, to twinkle. And we rejoice in it, hallelujah!

That is why the ministry has changed over the years from trying to fight our way through, bulldoze our way through, and cut all the trees out of the way to make a way. No, we have come into a different mentality as we have come into the gospel of the fullness of Christ, knowing for sure that the Holy Ghost has been withdrawn in the sense of being the predominant power going forth. But the Wife of the Lamb has a gospel that is reflective of those feminine attributes that were in God before the world was. And when God looks at us, He sees the Wife of the Lamb, and She is clothed in fine linen, clean and white, which is the righteousness that He has given to us. And, oh, yes! She does not only have the gift of the Holy Ghost, but She has the Giver of the Holy Ghost as Her Husband, for She has the second benefit and is wearing the crown of glory.

Let us continue reading in John 16:12. Jesus says, "I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now." He was saying this to them in that day even before the Holy Ghost came. But now we wear the crown of glory and we are not carrying a cross or unnecessary burdens as His Wife. We can see that He the Holy Ghost (the masculine part of Christ) has a permanent dwelling place in the Lord

Jesus Christ, while the feminine part of Christ has a permanent dwelling place in the body of Christ, which God says is the Wife of the Lamb. So there is the male and female working together perfectly. And we can see that Christ has finally arrived home; for the masculine part fell right into the Lord Jesus Christ as was ordained from the beginning, and the feminine part (attributes) fell right into the body of Christ making Her the Wife of the Lamb. Now here we see the completion of the Godhead—God the eternal Spirit; His Son the Lamb of God in glorified flesh and bones; and the Lamb's Wife in glorified flesh and bones as the tree of life bearing Her fruits. There is the Godhead!

When the Holy Ghost was withdrawn, we see the antichrist spirit took over the religious world, which could not have been done until that time. But Iesus said in the garden, "Now you can do what you are to do because this is the time of the power of darkness." Then Paul wrote in 2 Thessalonians 2:6-7, "And now ye know what withholdeth that he (the antichrist) might be revealed in his time. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only He who now letteth will let, until He (the Holy Ghost) be taken out of the way." And now it has happened. Now look what is in the religious world today. And all this is here at the same time that the Wife of the Lamb is on the scene being glad and rejoicing. And one thing about the Wife, She is not tossed to and fro. She is one hundred percent sure; and She is not trying to prove this little point or trying to prove that little point, or trying to bump heads, or trying to be a little different in order to get a name or some recognition.

Now let us go on to Verse 13. "Howbeit when he, (the Holy Ghost) the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew (show) you things to come." How many he's are in that one verse? The word he is in that one verse six times. We do not find She; we do not find Wife; we do not find virgin; we only find he, he, he, he, he, he! And then we start off with the next verse; watch what it says. Verses 14-15, "He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you." I want us to notice—he, him. But when we get over to Paul's preaching, we began to get a strange doctrine when we compare it with all the he's here, because Paul began to say she. And one of the places this is seen is in 1 Corinthians 11:2, where Paul said, "For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one Husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to the glorified Jesus Christ." And in Paul's writings we find the words she, her, virgin, wife, and all these things began to come into focus, thus showing the feminine part of Christ. But notice here, first the He, the masculine part, of Christ had to come forth and manifest itself in the **Holy Ghost.**

In the days gone by, people used to talk about the Holy Ghost. If you said *Holy Ghost* two or three times, the people would be ready to start shouting! And they would say, "I have got the Holy Ghost!" And some of the preachers would ask, "Do you have the Holy Ghost?" And you might say, "I am not sure what you are talking about; I have Christ." And they would say, "Have you spoken in tongues? Because if you have not spoken in tongues, then

you do not have it, because speaking in tongues is the evidence that you have the Holy Ghost." But contrary to what they said, there is not a scripture in the Bible that will back that up. But the point that I am making is that I am not trying to be controversial with those that would say that, because they do not realize that day is in the past; so they keep putting emphasis on the Holy Ghost. Well, that was all right in times past, because She was yet to be revealed. So speaking in unknown tongues, yes, that is a gift of God, and we have explained before that not everyone speaks in tongues; but in the past, many people spoke in tongues with the receiving of the gift of the Holy Ghost. But now it is *She* the Wife of the Lamb that is shining forth. So we the Wife have moved with the revelation of God's Word, and we understand that others cannot understand this truth because they have not moved with God's Word in revelation to the point of knowing that the marriage of the Lamb has taken place.

When God gets ready to bring something in, it happens, it just comes into being, and then when it does, we can begin to see it so clearly. So now the river of life is shown flowing through the Wife of the Lamb. And there is a gospel that is dealing with the She part of Christ in the realm of the Wife of the Lamb, and it is not always exclusively dealing with the He part of Christ, although the river is flowing through *Him* and on through *Her*, it is *She* that is now being manifested. Jesus was *He* the tree of life when He walked around here on earth, and the tree of life was manifested right through Him to the point that He did not have to die. But He *did* die, but He did not have to, because He said in John 10:18, "No man takes my life from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it

down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of my Father." So that ends the argument (if there is one) that says they murdered Jesus. No, Jesus laid down His life; otherwise, they could not have done anything. He allowed it. And then He picked His life back up again. That is the power of the Word right there. And He was the anointed Word made flesh walking around. And within Him was the feminine attributes, but they were basically dormant, except we do see that from time to time the feminine attributes would come out in the things Jesus said and done. But now it is the day of the Woman. It was not the day of the Woman then. But *this* is the day of the She part of Christ manifesting the fullness of the man Christ Jesus in His Wife.

During each one of the seven church ages, they had to Take for instance Brother William fight for truth. Branham's message; his wife would say to him, "Bill, why do you hit the people so hard? You start talking to them real good, and soon you are just fussing at them. You are condemning the women. You are condemning nearly everything. Why?" And he said, "Well, I do not know. It just seems to come upon me." See, he had to do that! That was the Holy Ghost fighting! So what did Brother Branham do? He fought the battle; he cut a trail like John the Baptist. He made a smooth way; and here we are rejoicing in that smooth way. Then here came Brother Raymond Jackson Jr., influenced by Michael the archangel; and do not think that he would not fight! But now, here is a ministry that does not have much desire to fight at all. We are the Wife of the Lamb, and we know that God is placing everything just as He ordained it before the foundation of the world.

Notice our title again, The Day of He, the Holy Ghost, and the Day of She, the Wife of the Lamb. And in this day of She, the Wife of the Lamb, we have come into this moment of the twinkling of an eye. Praise God, He spared us a moment. God spared the Wife of His Son a moment; and She is on display now. Miracles are taking place. The twinkling of an eye is taking place. And the glory of God is falling all around us. And the river of life is flowing from God, through the Son, and right on through the Wife of the Lamb, and She is bearing Her fruit. And the Wife of the Lamb knows these last three fruits are here; yes, they are here, and we are enjoying all three-the message of the shout, the voice of the archangel, and the trump of God (which is now sounding; for the trumpet is being blown by the ministry of the Wife of the Lamb, and it is catching every one that has an ear to hear). It is just like a large magnet being pulled through a building where there are metal shavings; every one of the steel shavings goes right to it, but the magnet has no effect on the aluminum shavings at all. The only effect it would have is if some of the metal shavings rub across them and move them a little bit. So if they just get caught in that, they will eventually fall right off, because when you pick that magnet up and shake it a little bit, it will be obvious that there was no force of magnetism holding the aluminum shavings. But the Wife of the Lamb is magnetized to this message and cannot be shaken off.

So this moment of the twinkling of an eye is the little space of time that God spared for the Wife of the Lamb. She is part of the Lamb's Book of Life, and She is part of the

Godhead. Can you imagine God taking a little group and making them part of the Godhead? Oh, what an honor He has bestowed upon us; for through Her that water (the Spirit of life) flows, and it goes out to the nations!

In Revelation 19:7-8, God through John identified the body of Christ, and God calls Her *Wife*, the She part of Christ, which is the tree of life. Notice, it is *Her*, not Him. Now I want you to watch, this is Revelation 22:1-2, God calls the tree of life *Her* here. It has always been *Him*, but here He calls it *Her*. She is the tree of life and the river of life is coming through Her in this moment that we are living in. Hallelujah, now we have glorified flesh and bones!

Yes, when Christ came through the Holy Ghost, people were saved; and, yes, they died with the Holy Ghost. But all those who were part of the Wife have now come forth and are glorifying God. Also, there were other born again people, but they are of a different order of saints; they are seen dressed in white robes, and they are so proud of those white robes; for they are before the throne with palms in their hands, rejoicing! But here is a little group, the Wife of the Lamb, who is dressed in fine linen; which makes us part of the Godhead. We are so different, and we think differently. We are not here to fight. We are here to rejoice. We are here to make love with this anointed Word of God. It is all here taking place now. Amen.

So the tree of life goes from Him to Her, and the river of life flows through Him and then on through Her. And that is the honor that Jesus Christ and God the Father is bestowing upon the Wife, that the life has to flow through Her. She is the one doing the bearing of the fruit.

Notice, the Word came from God our Father, on to Jesus Christ, and then to His Wife. And now it has become a clear picture as we get these messages and read them all, for we will find out that they are perfectly the Word. But ultimately it takes a revelation. It was that way also with things that Jesus Christ did; multitudes saw the many miracles that He did, walking on the water, multiplying the fish and loaves, and all these things, yet when He asked His disciples, "Whom do men say that I the Son of man am?" They said, "Some say you are John that is raised from the dead. Some say you are Elijah." But Jesus said, "Who do you say that I am?" And now He is asking, "Who do you say you are?" I am not saying, "Who do you say He is," we know that. But who do **you** say that **you** are? With revelation you can say, "I am the Wife of the Lamb, and I have on the fine linen, clean and white, and I am part of the Godhead. And the river of life flows right through me." And we will claim it and rejoice in it!

In closing I want to say this: Soon we will be together visibly with those that went on before us but have now come forth, and together we will be caught up. Together we will go up to the throne, and together we will be with Him. Together we will come back to this earth, and together we will make this earth a place for our Father to come back home again.

O' precious Father, I pray that you will bless this Word. May it go forth, and may you take it and use it for your glory, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.
