

**MATERIALS****Caron® Simply Soft® Party** (3 oz/85 g; 164 yds/150 m)**Contrast A** Royal Sparkle (0005) **1 ball****Contrast B** Purple Sparkle (0006) **1 ball****Contrast C** Spring Sparkle (0003) **1 ball**Size U.S. 1/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size to obtain gauge.** 23" [58.5 cm] cream organdy ribbon (for small bag)— $\frac{3}{8}$ " [10 mm]. 29" [73.5 cm] cream organdy ribbon (for medium bag)— $\frac{7}{8}$ " [22 mm]. 1 yd [91.5 cm] sage green wired organdy ribbon (for large bag)— $1\frac{1}{2}$ " [38 mm]. Yarn needle.**ABBREVIATIONS:** www.yarnspirations.com/abbreviations**MEASUREMENTS****Small:** 3½ x 5½" [9 x 14 cm]**Medium:** 6¼ x 9" [16 x 23 cm]**Large:** 10 x 12" [25.5 x 30.5 cm]**GAUGE**

Gauge is not critical for this project.

INSTRUCTIONS**SMALL BAG**

With A, ch 27. (See diagram on page 2)

Row 1 (RS): 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook (first (sc, 2 dc) group made), *sk next 2 ch, (sc, 2 dc) in next ch; repeat from * across to last 3 ch, sk next 2 ch, sc in last ch, turn—8 (sc, 2 dc) groups.**Row 2:** Ch 2, 2 dc in first sc, sk next 2 dc, *(sc, 2 dc) in next sc, sk next 2 dc; repeat from * across to turning ch, sc in 2nd ch of turning ch, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 5½" [14 cm] from beginning, end with a RS row. Fasten off, leaving a long enough tail to sew side and bottom seam.

Finishing

Block if desired. Fold piece in half, bringing side edges together. Sew side and bottom seam. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends. Weave the 23" [58.5 cm] ribbon through stitches, about 1¼" [3 cm] below top edge, beginning at center front of bag. Tie ends of ribbon into a bow and trim ends.

MEDIUM BAG

With B, ch 48. (See diagram on page 2).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook, *ch 1, sk next ch, sc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn—23 ch-1 sps.**Row 2:** Ch 1, sk first sc, *sc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk next sc; repeat from * across, sc in beginning ch-1, turn.Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 8½" [21.5 cm] from beginning, end with a WS row. **Do not** fasten off.**Ruffle (RS):** Ch 1, sc in first ch-1 sp, *ch 3, sc in next sc, ch 3, sc in next ch-1 sp; repeat from * across working last sc in beginning ch-1. Fasten off, leaving a long enough tail to sew side and bottom seams.



Finishing

Block if desired. Fold piece in half, bringing side edges together. side and bottom seam. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends. Weave the 28" [71 cm] ribbon through stitches, about 2" [2.5 cm] below top edge, beginning at center front of bag. Tie ends of ribbon into a bow and trim ends.

Finishing

Block if desired. Fold piece in half, bringing side edges together. Sew side and bottom seam. Using yarn needle, weave in all ends. Weave the 1 yd [91.5 cm] ribbon through stitches, about 2½" [6 cm] below top edge, beginning at center front of bag. Tie ends of ribbon into a bow and trim ends.

LARGE BAG

With C, ch 62.

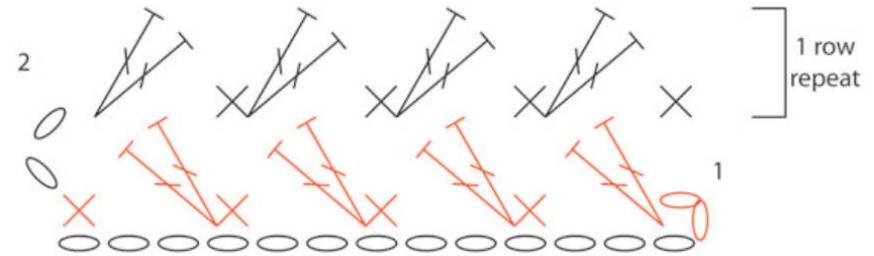
Row 1 (RS): Dc in 2nd ch from hook, *sc in next ch, dc in next ch; repeat from * across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first dc, *dc in next sc, sc in next dc; repeat from * across, dc in beginning ch-1, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 11½" [29 cm] from beginning, end with a WS row. **Do not** fasten off.

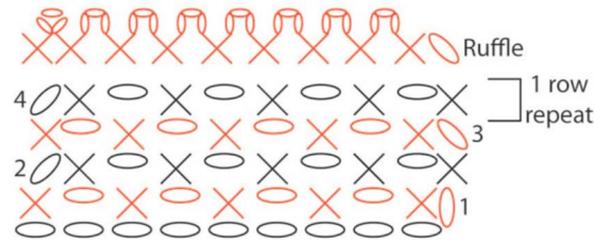
Ruffle (RS): Ch 1, sl st in first dc, *3 dc in next sc, sl st in next dc; repeat from * across. Fasten off, leaving a long enough tail to sew side and bottom seams.

Stitch Pattern for Small Bag



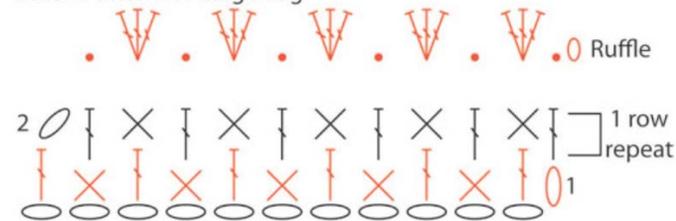
- = chain (ch)
