<u>Van Gilmer</u>, is a renowned vocal soloist, pianist, composer, and choral director who since 2005, has served as Music Director at the Bahá'í House of Worship in Wilmette, IL. He was awarded the 2001 Gold Prize at the Johannes Brahms International Choral Festival and the Independent Music Award's "Best Gospel Song" for 2006. Van Gilmer has performed as soloist with choirs on tours in Russia, India, Europe, and the United States, and has twice appeared at Carnegie Hall. His rich and soulful tenor voice has been heard in concerts and recordings with the Maly Moscow Symphony, the Slovak Radio Symphony, the Warsaw Philharmonic, the Czech National Symphony and the Budapest Symphony.
