What is a Core Team?

The Core Team is the hands and feet of youth ministry. They are the people from the parish who support the goals of youth ministry by offering their time and talent. The Core Team is meant to form deep relationships with the people involved in ministry and be spiritually rewarding to those involved while cultivating an attitude of service in the greater community.

Who is a Core Member?

- ❖ A Catholic adult who has a love for God and a love for teens
- ❖ Someone with a mature outlook on life, who has a servant mentality and the ability to commit to being a mentor for the teens of our parishes
- ❖ A person of prayer and faith, regularly receiving the sacraments, who is a witness to the Gospel and the love of Christ with a servant heart
- ❖ Someone willing to share their gifts and talents with youth

How does a Core Member serve the youth?

- ❖ By being an authentic witness in the community
- ❖ By being present at youth ministry events and programming
- ❖ By doing a specific job to support the youth coordinator

What would my responsibilities be?

- ❖ Live out your faith daily & promote Catholic identity
- ❖ Choose one aspect of ministry to be your specific job
- ❖ Regularly attend programming of your choice (Youth Group, Lifeline, Service Days, retreats, hospitality, etc)
- ❖ Attend monthly (or bi-monthly) meetings meant to help us grow in community, spirituality and service; as well as help plan themes for Sunday gatherings.
- ❖ Be open to various training opportunities throughout the year.
- ❖ You may have to call or talk with people to recruit others.

Qualifications

- ❖ VIRTUS training and background check
- ❖ Driver's license check (if driving youth may be involved)
- ❖ Need to read & sign Archdiocese Volunteer Code of Conduct form annually
