What is a Core Team?

The Youth Core Team is the hands and feet of youth ministry. The youth core team is to help the youth minister and Adult Core Team in supporting youth ministry. A Youth Core Team member is a catholic youth who has a love for God, can relate with youth, can connect youth with other Christians, can help youth grow in their faith, and honor God with their life.”

Who is a Core Member?

- ❖ A 9th - 12th grader who wants to grow in the Catholic faith..
- ❖ Someone who is prayerful and excited about their faith, who regularly receiving the sacraments, and is a witness to the Gospel and the love of Christ
- ❖ Someone willing to share their gifts and talents to serve the youth of the parishes

How does a Core Member serve the youth?

- ❖ By being an authentic witness in the community and to their peers.
- ❖ By being present at youth ministry events and programs..
- ❖ By doing a specific job to support the youth minister or Adult Core Team.

What would my responsibilities be?

- ❖ Live out your faith every day
- ❖ Choose one aspect of ministry to be your specific job
- ❖ Regularly attend programming of your choice (Youth Group, Lifeline, Service Days, retreats, etc)
- ❖ Take on leadership roles, assist with setup, cleanup, and other needs.
- ❖ Be a role model for other teens and report any suspected cases of abuse.
- ❖ Attend monthly (or bi-monthly) meetings meant to help us all grow in community, spirituality and service.
- ❖ Be open to various training opportunities throughout the year.
- ❖ Encourage other youth to come to events and programs. .

Qualifications

- ❖ Need to read & sign Archdiocese Volunteer Code of Conduct form annually
- ❖ Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher/coach or other non-family adult
