

Estimated SRECs Req. ~1.9 mm SRECs


Estimated Avg. Annual MW Balance Needed*

Last six month average MW/month has decreased. Q4 2014 build rates are up.



NJ SREC SUPPLY AND FORECAST

Through November 2014 Issuance

- ~580k EY2013 and EY2014 SRECs remain
- ~820k EY2015 SRECs have been issued
- Forecast another ~860k EY2015 SRECs
- EY2015 oversupply ~350k SRECs



ELECTRICITY SALES (MWh) AND SRECs REQUIRED

SREC demand set by electricity sales

- BGS Auction in February
- Recent years have declined or are flat
- EY2014 = 76.5 mm MWh
- No growth impacts SRECs required



NJ SUPPLY / DEMAND SCENARIOS - ELECTRICITY SALES REMAIN FLAT


With reduced demand, market remains oversupplied in Case 2

Existing and lower build rates result in undersupply beginning EY2017



Current NJ15 market: \$215 @ \$225


