Tonight's Games

It's the finale of a three-game series and the final regular-season series of the year between these two clubs. The Pheasants have lost both games of the series, including last night's 8-2 loss. The Pheasants trail Winnipeg by 10 ½ games for the league's only wild card spot with 24 games remaining.

LAST TIME OUT: Rusch's gem beats Pheasants

The Winnipeg Goldeyes used a five-run second inning and a complete-game performance from the league's top pitcher en route to an 8-2 defeat of the Sioux Falls Pheasants on Tuesday night at Winnipeg's Shaw Park.

Goldeyes starter Matthew Rusch (8-2) earned his first complete-game victory of the year, holding the Pheasants to just two runs and five hits. Rusch lowered his league-leading ERA to 2.37 and beat the Pheasants for the third time this season.

For the eighth time this year, Winnipeg scored five or more runs in an inning against Pheasants pitching. Pheasants starter Barry Fowler (1-1) was the latest victim in the second inning. Amos Ramon hit a two-run single to start the rally, and Jose Duran and Chris Roberson also had RBI hits.

The Pheasants' only runs came from Jared Bolden's two-run double in the third inning.

Winnipeg added singletons in the third, fourth and sixth innings.

Fowler gave up all eight runs, seven earned, on 13 hits in six innings pitched. He walked two and struck out two in the loss.

Kyle Mertins and Alan DeRatt each pitched a scoreless inning in relief of Fowler.

Cesar Nicolas had the only multi-hit performance of the night for the Pheasants. His team-best average is .344. Reggie Abercrombie went hitless for the first time since returning to Sioux Falls.

PHEASANTS NEWS: Pheasants surpass 100,000 fans in 2012

The Sioux Falls Pheasants concluded a home stand on Sunday evening and vaulted past the 100,000 season attendance milestone, the first time the club has done so since 2009.

The Pheasants have averaged 2,511 fans per game through 40 openings, an increase of nearly 61 percent over the average in 2011. With nine home games remaining, the Pheasants are on pace to see more than 123,000 total fans by season's end.

"It's exciting to see the direction we are headed," said Pheasants CEO/President Tom Garrity. "The fan support has been outstanding, and I know our corporate sponsors have been thrilled with the increase. We hope to finish strong and build some momentum into next season."

Clegg joins the Pheasants following three seasons with the Washington Nationals organization, who selected him in the 2009 draft out of the University of Massachusetts. That year, Clegg earned mid-season all-star honors in the short-season New York-Penn League. With Class A Potomac last year, the southpaw split time as a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.50 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 29 appearances.

2011: Began season as starter and made 10 consecutive starts...Moved to relief role on 6/16...Tossed three consecutive scoreless appearances across eight innings, 7/25 - 8/5. **2010 (Hagerstown):** Undeclared in first 14 appearances...Converted 2 of 2 save opportunities to begin season...Moved to starting role on 5/18 and went 5-0 in first seven starts...Went 2-1, 0.91 ERA in June with five starts...Pitched 17+ scoreless innings across three starts, 6/8-6/18. **2010 (GCL):** Reassigned after shoulder problems and fatigue. **2009:** Mid-season All-Star...Earned victory in professional debut, 6/21...Did not allow a run in first three appearances (7 IP)...Moved to starting role on 7/1 and made nine consecutive starts...Only allowed one home run. **Misc:** Drafted by Washington Nationals in 21st round of 2009 draft...Pitched at University of Massachusetts...Played amateur hockey.

BIRDS AND FISH: Sioux Falls and Winnipeg renewed a rivalry last year that began in 1994. The Pheasants are 75-108 all-time against the Goldeyes. Sioux Falls had winning seasons in 1996 and 1999 against Winnipeg

OH, CANADA: The Pheasants are in the midst of a stretch where 14 of 20 games are against Canadian teams. The Pheasants just hosted their first interleague series in team history against the Quebec Capitales and won the series 3-1. The Pheasants are 7-13 against Canadian opponents.

SERIES-LY: The series victory against Quebec was the first since the Pheasants swept Gary SouthShore June 30 – July 2. The Pheasants have won eight of 22 series this year, but just two of 10 on the road.

TOUGH ROAD: The Pheasants are in the midst of a span that started July 3 where 33 of 37 games are against opponents with winning percentages above .500. Every opponent except Sioux City is currently in first or second place in its division/league. Against teams that are currently above .500 (Fargo-Moorhead, Winnipeg, Kansas City, St. Paul, Quebec and Wichita), the Pheasants are 19-28.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Pheasants are 23-17 at home this season. After starting 2-4 at home, they have won 21 of their last 35 contests at Sioux Falls Stadium.

MONTHLY REPORT: Each month has been the best or worst of times. The Pheasants went 16-10 in June, the third best record in the league for the month. The Pheasants hit a league-best .318 and had the third lowest ERA at 3.99. It was a significant turnaround from a 6-8 May performance, where the Pheasants hit a league-worst .270 and had the highest team ERA at 6.60. But in July, the Pheasants went 10-19 (12th) with a .273 team average (11th) and a 5.34 ERA (13th).

In August, the Pheasants are 2-5 with a .259 average and a 6.47 ERA.

THESE COUNT: 17 of 29 games in July were against Fargo-Moorhead or Winnipeg. However, the Pheasants have already completed their 12-game schedule against the St. Paul Saints. In August and early September, the Pheasants have just six of their last 31 games against division foes. In division play this year, the Pheasants are 14-22.

WHIFF-ER LESS: A few Pheasants batter have shown an exceptional eye. Through August 5, Jared Bolden has struck at a rate of once per 8.6 at-bats and once per 9.5 plate appearances. Al Quintana is striking out once per 9.6 at-bats.

DEFENSIVE: The Pheasants defense is fourth in the league with a .974 fielding percentage and the fourth fewest errors (77). They lead the league with 91 double plays turned. Cory Morales is the top fielding shortstop in the league with just eight errors in 326 chances (.979).

FIVE ALIVE: The Pheasants are 27-13 when scoring five or more runs. They are 29-13 when holding opponents to five runs or less.

CAR POOL: 34 of 71 Pheasants home runs have come with men on base. Two have been grand slams.

BIG INNING WOES: The Pheasants have given up five or more runs in one inning on 20 occasions, and eight have been against Winnipeg. The last time they did so was August 7 (Winnipeg, second inning).

ONE-RUN WOES: The Pheasants have scored just one run in a game eight times this season. Seven came in July.

PLAYER NOTES

SHIRLEY YOU CAN'T BE SERIOUS: Sioux Falls manager Steve Shirley is in his sixth season leading the Pheasants. On June 4, Shirley notched his 300th victory as a manager. He managed part of 2005 with the Sioux City Explorers before coming to Sioux Falls in 2007. His career managerial record is 325-299. Shirley has the most wins in Sioux Falls, where he is 292-267 all-time.

STREAKY: On June 30, Cesar Nicolas snapped a career-high, 19-game hitting-streak. Nicolas went 30-for-74 (.405) with seven doubles, two home runs and 18 RBI. He also scored 15 runs. The streak was the longest of the season for a Pheasants player. The all-time record is 22, set by Jermaine Swinton in 2001.

TREVOR LAWHORN BREAKS GAMES PLAYED RECORD: On June 16, Trevor Lawhorn broke the all-time games played mark in Sioux Falls Pheasants/Canaries history, 320 set by Felix Pagan.

Lawhorn has batted .277 in his Sioux Falls career with 43 home runs and 197 RBI. Earlier this season, Lawhorn broke Pagan's all-time doubles record. He is second all-time with 396 hits. Earlier in June, the *Argus-Leader* named him to their Sioux Falls Canaries/Pheasants All-Time Team. In July, fans voted Lawhorn to the 20th-Anniversary Team. Lawhorn has played more games at third base than any other Sioux Falls player. Lawhorn was a 2010 American Association all-star and MVP of the 2009 American Association All-Star Game. He played three seasons in the Cincinnati Reds organization before joining Sioux Falls for his first stint in 2007. The Washington Nationals signed him midway through the 2007 season. He rejoined Sioux Falls in 2009.

ACTIVE ANTHONSEN: Right behind Trevor Lawhorn in games played is Joe Anthonson, who has played 352 games with Sioux Falls, good for second all-time in team history. He has played all but 15 of a possible 368 games since joining Sioux Falls for the 2009 season. Anthonson already holds team career records for runs scored (230) and walks (233).

QUALITY CLEGG: Seven of Mitchell Clegg's 15 starts on the mound have been quality (6IP or more, 3 ER allowed or less).

GUERRERO POWER: Cristian Guerrero is second in league with 15 home runs and is on a pace to hit 19 home runs this season. Since July 13, he has homered just once.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW? Some notable Pheasants from last year have relocated. **Ben Moore** began the year in the Atlantic League but is now playing in Taiwan. **Brandon Sing** is playing with the Long Island Ducks of the independent Atlantic League.

ALUMNI REPORT

Eddy Rodriguez (2010) was signed by the San Diego Padres last year and was called up to the big leagues last week. He made his major-league debut on August 2 and homered in his first at-bat. He is 1-for-5 overall in two games with a home run and an RBI. Earlier this season he attended big-league camp as a non-roster invitee this spring. He was assigned to the Lake Elsinore Storm, the Padres' advanced-A affiliate. He hit .223 with 13 home runs and 36 RBI in 87 games this year. Rodriguez has experience with both the Padres' Double-A and Triple-A clubs.

Cody Evans (2012) is 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA in four relief appearances and one start with the Dunedin Blue Jays (high-A, Florida State League). His last appearance was August 4, when he started and threw four innings against Daytona. He allowed two runs and two hits and took a no-decision. Evans began the year with the Pheasants and notched eight saves.

George Sherrill (2001) appeared in just two games with Seattle Mariners this season and underwent season-ending Tommy John surgery on May 4. This year he went 0-0 with a 27.00 ERA in 1 1/3 innings. His last appearance was April 9. Last year with the Atlanta Braves, Sherrill was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in 51 relief appearances. Sherrill was a 2008 MLB All-Star with the Baltimore Orioles. He now has appeared in over 400 major league games with a career ERA below 4.00.
