

# JOHN CARROLL FOOTBALL 2011

The Blue and Gold took a momentary sigh of relief last week. It took five tries, but John Carroll finally pieced together its most balanced, complete game of the season en route to their first win in Wilmington in six years, 44-7. Back in comfortable, though unfamiliar territory, the Blue Streaks find themselves tied for second in the Ohio Athletic Conference. John Carroll enters play today averaging over 500 yards of offense each of the last three games while coming off their best defensive performance of the season.

John Carroll followed week one and week two losses to Case Western Reserve and #2 Mount Union with high-powered offense to ignite a three game win streak over Marietta, Otterbein and Wilmington. Devin O'Brien passed for 210 yards on 19-26 through the air, while Anthony D'Aurizio carried the rock 12 times for 105 yards (the team ran for 271). He became the third different Blue Streak back in as many weeks to top the century mark on the ground. Seven different receivers caught passes from O'Brien in the win, led by freshman Joe Quinzio (five catches for 57 yards and a TD).

John Carroll enjoyed the thrilling win last weekend, but they can't afford to lose focus against Muskingum. The Muskies have one of the most stout defenses in the country this season and -- after their best start to a season since 1996 by winning their first four games -- they are coming off of their first loss of 2011.

Also tied for second in the OAC, Muskingum has been a thorn in John Carroll's side in recent past with two late-game wins. If recent matchups are any foreshadowing for this afternoon's contest, expect fans to stay in their seats for the full 60 minutes. The last time the Muskies visited Don Shula Stadium, the Blue Streaks lost on a heart-breaking "Hail Mary" as time expired.

**The Teams:** The John Carroll University Blue Streaks (3-2, 3-1 OAC) will host the Fighting Muskies of Muskingum University (4-1, 3-1 OAC) in week six action of the regular season.

**The Series:** In a series that dates back to 1933, this will be the 26th meeting between the Blue Streaks and the Muskies. John Carroll leads the all-time series 19-5-1. Each of the last three games in this series have been decided by seven points or less.

**Players To Watch For John Carroll:** Senior quarterback **Devin O'Brien** leads the offense. He has accounted for 1,197 yards of total offense through the first five games (853 passing, 344 rushing) and has accounted for 10 touchdowns. He earned his second career OAC Offensive Player of the Week Award for his efforts against Otterbein. His 239.4 yards of total offense per game trails only Otterbein's Autstin Schlosser in the conference ... The JCU offense has been very successful in their running back by committee approach over the last two weeks. Against Marietta and Otterbein, the Streaks ran the ball for 363 and 379 yards. **Casey Vogl** (168 yards), **Sean Kuenzig** (161 yards), **DaQuan Grobsmith** (110 yards), **Anthony D'Aurizio** (102 yards) and **Domonic De La Riva** (69 yards) have all seen double-digit touches through the first five weeks, helping the team rush for 238.0 yards per game ... Last week, D'Aurizio eclipsed the 100 yard rushing mark for the first time in his career. He is averaging 8.6 yards per carry this year, best on the team ... After John Carroll graduated arguably the best wide receiver in school history last year in Frank Ross, the questions surrounding the wide receiving corps going into this season have seemingly been answered. Junior wide out **Lane Robilotto** has hauled in 19 passes for 283 yards and a score in his first five games donning the Blue and Gold. His most productive game came in week four against Otterbein, where he had six receptions for 109 yards. He stands alone in fourth place in the OAC in All-Purpose Yards (135.8), and his 275 all-purpose yards last week was the 16th best single-game effort by a Division III player this season ... Junior **Luke McCall** has snagged 12 balls for 155 yards in his first consistent action on the varsity squad ... Junior tight end **Ben Madden** has caught 11 passes for 129 yards on the season as well, including a touchdown in the first overtime period against Otterbein ... Freshman **Joe Quinzio** has come up with eight big catches for 120 yards and his first collegiate touchdown last week against Wilmington ... Defensively, senior linebacker **C.J. Seitzinger** leads the Blue Streaks with 34 tackles (17th in the OAC). He is now only 53 tackles shy of becoming the eighth player in school history to amass 300 career stops. *The Sporting News* preseason All-American leads a group of veteran linebackers that include seniors **Emmett Lydon** and **Brian Schneider** ... Junior cornerback **D.J. Debick** has been noteworthy so far, recording 12 tackles (one for loss), one interception, one fumble recovery and disrupting five passes ... Sophomore cornerback **Ryan Winchell** has made 32 tackles in three games for JCU ... Junior defensive linemen **Dan Valore** and **Mike Green** have been a handful this year. Valore leads all D-linemen with 17 tackles, four tackles for loss, 3.5 sacks and two quarterback hurries. Green has added an additional 3.5 tackles for loss and 2.5 sacks, as well as a safety against Marietta ... Sophomore **Alex Cameron** has made 23 stops and recovered a fumble in his first five games for the Blue Streaks at safety. His 16 tackles in week two is a career-high ... Freshman kicker **Kresimir "Crash" Ivkovic** is 5-8 on field goal tried this year. He nailed his first collegiate field goal from 26 yards out against Case. He narrowly missed a 51-yard attempt against Marietta, which would have been one yard shy of a school record. He has averaged 62.0 yards on 26 kickoffs this year and he remains the only kicker in the OAC who has not yet missed an extra point attempt (17-17) ... Senior punter **Mike Malisheski** has averaged 39.1 yards per punt this season, 3rd in the OAC.

**Defensive Struggles:** 2011 has not been kind thus far to the JCU defense. Entering play last weekend, the Blue Streaks ranked last in the OAC in total defense and scoring defense, 9th in pass defense and opponent's first downs and 7th in rush defense and red zone defense. But they finally had a game they could hang their hats on against the Quakers. **CJ Seitzinger** and company held the Quaker rushing attack to only 25 yards, while allowing 201 passing yards and one touchdown pass. After that performance, the Streaks upped their conference rankings in most of those defensive categories: scoring defense (7th), total defense (8th), opponent's first downs (6th), red zone defense (6th) and opponent third down conversions (3rd).

**Offensive Fireworks:** John Carroll has been outstanding offensively over the last three weeks, averaging 505.6 yards per game and scoring 15 touchdowns. Along with Heidelberg, they currently have the best offensive line in the conference, allowing only three sacks per game. They rank first in the OAC in time of possession (35:03), second in third down conversions (32-69, 46.4%), third in red zone offense (19-25 scores, including 13 touchdowns), third in first downs (112), second in rushing offense (238.0 yards per game) and third in total offense (411.8 yards per game). Also, their 30.4 points per contest checks in at third in conference play as well.

**Don't Leave Early:** As documented previously, this series has produced nailbiters in recent years. In 2008, Muskingum knocked home a 27-yard field goal for a 15-14 win and continued the late game drama with a "Hail Mary" touchdown pass with no time left in a 34-31 victory over the Blue Streaks the last time the Muskies came to town in 2009. John Carroll got its revenge last season though, with a 24-17 win late in the fourth quarter thanks to a **Corey Castro** one-yard touchdown run.

**Over The Hump:** After beating Wilmington last week, John Carroll posts a record above .500 for the first time since they started the 2009 season 2-1, before finishing 3-7.

**A Tough Road Ahead:** With the season half over, the Blue Streaks find themselves tied for second place in the OAC. Unfortunately, they have a very tough road ahead. As it currently stands, the Blue Streaks have the 16th hardest schedule in the country (ranked out of 236 teams) for the remaining games this season. No team in the conference will face opponents whose current combined records are that high.

**Red Zone Rarity:** No team in NCAA football at any level was more successful than John Carroll last season at scoring the football when inside the 20. The Blue Streaks cashed in on points an astounding 29 out of 30 times (97% success rate) throughout the course of the season. Impressively, 25 of the 29 scores were touchdowns (20 rushing, five passing). In 2011, the Streaks have converted 19 of 25 tries for scores inside the red zone (13 touchdowns). The last two weeks, they have converted successfully on a combined 13 of 15 chances.

**Dominating The Line Of Scrimmage:** The Blue Streaks' offensive line has continued its solid protection this year. The best offensive line in the conference each of the past two seasons finds themselves atop the OAC leaderboard yet again thus far, allowing only three sacks in the first five weeks (one was a fumble recovery behind the line of scrimmage). They currently rank tied for 13th as the best line in the country in that category. For their efforts in helping generate 597 yards of total offense against Otterbein, including 379 on the ground, the Blue Streaks offensive line was named to D3football.com's team of the week. Defensively, the Streaks have done a nice job of getting to the ball carrier behind the line of scrimmage. The Streaks have amassed 22 tackles for loss, including 14 sacks already this season.

**The Penalized Streaks:** So far this season the Blue Streaks have been penalized 43 times for 368 yards (73.6 per game). Unfortunately, they have had three touchdowns negated because of penalties, including a **Lane Robilotto** punt return for six. Muskingum has been pretty solid this year, with only 36 penalties for 291 yards through five games.

**Don't Give It Away:** Turnovers were an Achilles heel for the Streaks last season. John Carroll finished last in the OAC in turnover margin at -12. Taking care of the football was a priority for the 2011 offense going into the first week. Despite a -4 margin in the first two contests, the Blue Streaks have only committed one turnover the last three games and currently stand at -5 on the season.

**All Over The Map:** Last weekend, the Blue Streaks made their second of three long road trips this year. Their five road games will amass 1,228 round-trip travel miles throughout the state of Ohio. The trip to Wilmington was the longest road trip of the year (212 miles to Wilmington, 162 miles to Ohio Northern and 161 miles to Marietta). The visit to Wilmington was the first of two overnight road trips for the team, as they head to Ohio Northern to take on the Polar Bears on October 22.

**Around the OAC:** All 10 teams in the OAC will kick off the second half of the regular season today. Marietta (0-4 OAC) will host Wilmington (0-4 OAC) for a 1:30 kickoff, Mount Union (4-0 OAC) travels to Heidelberg (3-1 OAC) in their quest to remain unbeaten (1:30 start), Ohio Northern (2-2 OAC) will take on Baldwin Wallace (3-1 OAC) in Berea at 2 pm and Capital (2-2 OAC) heads to Otterbein (0-4 OAC) for a 1:30 start.

**Run, Run and Run Some More:** The Blue Streaks seemed to establish an offensive identity this season that is similar to the one in 2010, in which they totaled more than 2,000 rushing yards for the first time since 1993. Over the last three weeks, JCU has averaged 337.6 yards per game rushing. They are on pace for over 2,300 yards this season, almost 200 yards more than a year ago.

**Making History:** John Carroll head coach Regis Scafe made history by just leading his team onto the field in the opener. He began his 13th season at the helm, making him the longest tenured head coach in the program's 91-year history. Jerry Schweickert (1965-76) and Tony DeCarlo (1987-1998) each manned the sidelines for 12 seasons. Coach Scafe is four wins shy of 100 during his 18 head coaching career (96-84, 80-49 at JCU).

**Up Next:** The Blue Streaks will hit the road again – destination Ada, Ohio. JCU posts a 14-10 all-time series lead over the Polar Bears, but has not beaten Ohio Northern in six years when they reached the half century mark in a 50-25 win on October 1st, 2005. Since reaching that offensive scoring plateau, the Blue Streaks have not scored more than 14 points in a game against the Polar Bears.
