



DAILY NOTES

LEADING OFF: The Raptors and the Orem Owlz play the second game of a best-of-three series. The Owlz lead the series 1-0. Orem won the season-series 8-7 this year. The Raptors have made the playoffs in six of the last seven seasons, playing Orem in the Divisional Round in five of those years.

LAST TIME OUT: The Raptors lost to the Owlz in Game 1, 8-3. Orem scored six runs in the second inning off Raptors starter **Brock Stewart**. **Cody Bellinger** had two hits with a triple and two RBI, and **Theo Alexander** had the only other two-hit day for Ogden. Orem's **Andrew Daniel** went 3-for-5 with a double and drove in three runs. **Juan Moreno** also had three hits for Orem.

FAMILIAR FACES: The Raptors return three players from 2013. Pitchers **Billy Flamion**, and **J.D. Underwood** and outfielder **Jacob Scavuzzo** all return to the Raptors from 2014.

PLAYOFF FORMAT: The season is split into two halves, with 38 games in each half. The first half ends on July 26 at home against Idaho Falls. The First-half winner will host Games 2 and 3 (if necessary) of the first round of the playoffs. Teams for the same division play a best-of-three series in the first round starting on Sept. 5. The championship round will also be best of three and will start on Sept. 9 with the Southern Division Champion hosting Games 2 and 3 (if necessary).

SCHEDULING QUIRKS: The Raptors will play 76 games this season, 38 in each half. The Raptors will play 16 games against divisional opponents (Grand Junction, Idaho Falls and Orem) and seven games against teams in the Northern Division (Billings, Great Falls, Helena and Missoula). All Raptors home games will start at 7:00, except Sunday when games will begin at 4:00.

LINDQUIST FIELD: The Raptors have called Lindquist Field home since 1997. Lindquist Field holds 7,000 people and has helped Ogden lead the league in attendance every year since it opened. BaseballParks.com named Lindquist Field the Best View in all of baseball and DigitalBallparks.com named it the 2007 Ballpark of the Year. The outfield wall from the left-field line to center field and the right-field fence is 16 feet high. The wall in the right-center gap, known as "Raptor Ridge," is 24 feet high. The bottom of the left-field wall is padded, and the top is lined with brick. Chain-link fence lines Lindquist Field from left-center to the right-field line. From home plate, the left-field line is 335 feet, center field is 390, right-center is 350 and the right-field line is 335 feet away. Mount Ben Lomond looks over left field, Lewis Peak over center field and Mount Ogden over right field.

LEAGUE AWARDS: The Pioneer League notices a Pitcher and Player each week of the season. Raptors pitcher **Jose De Leon** was named Pitcher of the Week for the week of Aug. 4-10. Against Helena, he pitched seven shutout innings and allowed just three hits with 11 strikeouts and no walks. De Leon was also named Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 23-29. In two starts against Orem, De Leon went 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA, striking out 18 batters, including 12 in seven innings on June 23 in a win. **Edinson Bock** won Pitcher of the Week for the week of June 16-22 earlier this season. He allowed no hits or runs over six innings, striking out seven and walking three, earning one win.

MANAGER JACK MCDOWELL: The Raptors skipper is in his first season as the field manager and in his first in the Dodgers organization. He was a 12-year veteran in the Major Leagues playing for the White Sox, Yankees, Indians and Angels. He was a three-time All Star and won the 1993 American League Cy Young Award with a 22-10 record, including 10 complete games and four shutouts. He was drafted by the White Sox with the fifth overall pick in 1987 after two All-American seasons at Stanford and a College World Series Championship.

PITCHING COACH GREG SABAT: The Raptors pitching coach is in his first season in the Dodgers organization. He previously served as the pitching coach with the Gulf Coast Tigers in Detroit's organization for 15 seasons where he also coordinated early Major League Camp for pitchers prior to Spring Training. In winter leagues, he has coached in Hermosillo, Mexico, the Dominican Republic and Venezuela.

HITTING COACH LEO GARCIA: The Raptors hitting coach is in his second season with the Raptors and his sixth in the Dodgers organization. He served as the hitting coach for the Arizona League Dodgers the previous four seasons. He spent the previous eight years as a coach and coordinator in the San Francisco minor league system, serving as that organization's Latin America coordinator in 2007 after six seasons as the hitting coach for the Giants' Rookie-level Arizona League club in Scottsdale from 2001-06. He also managed the Giants' Dominican Summer League team in 2000. He played 13 seasons of affiliated baseball in the White Sox, Reds and Royals organizations, including two Major League seasons with the Reds from 1987-88.

RECENT TRANSACTION: On Sept. 3, **Joe Meggs** was re-added to the Raptors roster after a day with AAA Albuquerque, and **Justin Chiboguo** was placed on the disabled list with a hand injury.
