ABOUT THE ARENA

Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena
300 A. Philip Randolph Blvd.
Jacksonville, FL 32202

Opened to the public in 2003, the Jacksonville Veterans Memorial Arena is a 15,000-seat multi-purpose facility that has played host to the NCAA Men's Division I Basketball Tournament on two occasions (2006, 2010). In addition to the Sharks, the arena is currently home to the ABA's Jacksonville Giants and the Jacksonville University Men's Basketball team, and also hosts a variety of concerts and other special events.

ABOUT THE SOUL



The Philadelphia Soul fell one win short of the ultimate prize in 2012, falling to the Arizona Rattlers in ArenaBowl XXV. Founded in 2004, the Soul battled through two losing seasons before making the playoffs for the first time in 2006. A run of three consecutive conference championship appearances culminated in a 59-56 win over the San Jose SaberCats in ArenaBowl XXII. That season, the Soul went 13-3 during the regular season, marking their first 10-win season as a franchise.

THE STORY SO FAR

2013 has been a season of streaks for the Jacksonville Sharks. The team began the season on fire, sprinting to a 6-0 start that left the Sharks as the last remaining unbeaten team in the Arena Football League. That six-win stretch included three straight road victories to open the year, back-to-back dominating defensive performances against New Orleans and Iowa, and a road win in Philadelphia that avenged last year's conference championship game.

But after that hot start, the Jacksonville offense went through a rough patch in the middle of the season. After scoring 60 or more points in each of the team's first four games, the Sharks did not cross the 60-point mark again until Week 11 against Pittsburgh. In the meantime, the team dropped three consecutive games against National Conference opponents - falling at home to the defending champion Arizona Rattlers, on the road at San Antonio and back home against San Jose.

Sitting at 6-3, and still in first place, the Sharks got back on the winning track in Week 10 at Orlando. Facing former Jacksonville quarterback Aaron Garcia for the first time, the Sharks emerged with a 44-41 win to improve to 7-3. The team followed that up with its first dominating offensive performance in some time, ripping off 70 points against Pittsburgh in Week 11.

With two straight wins in hand, the Sharks headed out west for a two-week road trip against Spokane and Utah. The team got off to a slow start against the Shock, and to make matters worse, starting quarterback Bernard Morris went down with an injury in what was a 76-41 Spokane victory. Forced to scramble at the quarterback position, the Sharks turned to veteran Kyle Rowley, who had won an ArenaBowl with Spokane. Rowley joined the team out west and immediately was inserted into the starting lineup, nearly leading the team to victory against Utah that week. Ultimately, however, the Blaze came out on top with a 62-55 win that dropped the Sharks to 8-5. Since that game in Utah, the Sharks have not left the comforts of home, playing back-to-back home games before the bye week. In Week 14, the

Sharks clinched a postseason berth with a dramatic 43-41 victory over the Cleveland Gladiators. Micheaux Robinson scored the final Jacksonville touchdown with a pick-six, then Terrance Smith recovered a Gladiator onside kick to seal the result. That win clinched the Sharks' fourth straight playoff berth.

Seven days later, Garcia and the Predators made a return trip to Sea Best Field. R.J. Archer got the start at quarterback, and went 16-of-20 with three touchdowns before leaving late in the first half with an ankle injury (Archer has since been put on injured reserve). Rowley came on in relief and accounted for five total touchdowns. The Predators kept the game close, but Smith swung momentum with two fourth-quarter interceptions, including one on the final play, to lock up a 62-55 Jacksonville win.

After clinching the team's fourth South Division title during the bye week, the Sharks returned to the field on July 13 for a rematch with the Spokane Shock. Though the game remained close into the second quarter, the Shock pulled away with back-to-back interception returns for touchdowns, eventually winning by a 62-40 count.

The Sharks righted the ship in Week 18, as Bernard Morris accounted for seven touchdowns and the team's front four racked up six sacks in a 58-49 victory over the New Orleans VooDoo.

Heading into the regular-season finale, the Sharks needed a win over the Tampa Bay Storm combined with a Philadelphia Soul loss to San Antonio to clinch the No. 1 seed. The Sharks did their part with a 52-44 victory, then watched as the Talons upset the Soul, vaulting Jacksonville to the top spot in the American Conference entering the postseason.

The Sharks opened the playoffs with a come-from behind victory over the Tampa Bay Storm. Jacksonville erased a 41-20 deficit, scoring 36 fourth-quarter points to emerge with a 69-62 win.

IF THE SHARKS WIN ...

- They would improve to 3-3 all-time against Philadelphia, and 1-1 against the Soul in the postseason.
- They would improve to 6-2 all-time in postseason play.
- They would improve to 5-1 all-time in home playoff games.

HEAD TO HEAD

The Sharks have an all-time record of 2-3 against the Soul. The teams have split four regular-season meetings, as Jacksonville recorded a victory in 2011 and 2013, while Philadelphia swept a pair of matchups in 2012.

The Soul defeated the Sharks in the 2012 American Conference Championship Game, the only previous postseason meeting between the two franchises.

QUICK HITS

-This is the Sharks' first home playoff game against a non-South Division opponent. Jacksonville is 4-1 all-time in postseason contests played on Sea Best Field.

-Jeff Hughley set a new postseason single-game franchise record with 283 all-purpose yards in last Saturday's win over the Tampa Bay Storm.

-The Sharks racked up 36 points in the fourth quarter of last week's game - the most points the team had ever scored in a quarter in franchise history. The Sharks had totaled 35 points in a quarter twice, against Iowa in May of 2011 and against the Arizona Rattlers in ArenaBowl XXIV.

DIVISION DOMINANCE

Now in their fourth season as a franchise, the Sharks have only lost one regular-season game against each of their current divisional opponents. Jacksonville is 7-1 all-time against Orlando, 7-1 all-time against Tampa Bay, and 5-1 against New Orleans. In addition, the Sharks are 4-1 against divisional foes in the postseason, defeating both Orlando and Georgia* en route to their ArenaBowl XXIV title.

The Coaches

JACKSONVILLE SHARKS HEAD COACH LES MOSS

Les Moss enters his fourth season as head coach of the ArenaBowl XXIV Champion Jacksonville Sharks. Moss has led the Sharks to a South Division title in each of his first three seasons with the team and was named AFL Coach of the Year in 2010, taking the Sharks to the playoffs in the team's inaugural season.

A coach with a longtime track record of success, Moss has brought his various teams to the postseason 23 times and has reached the playoffs every year since 1992, a string of 21 consecutive postseason births. 18 of those 23 teams have reached the "final four," with 12 making it to their respective league's championship game. Moss has won four Arena championships, in 1990, 1998, 2000 and 2011.

Moss began his Arena Football League career with the Chicago Bruisers in 1988. Two years later, he helped lead the Detroit Drive to the title in 1990. He then spent 12 years with the Orlando Predators beginning in their inaugural 1991 season. Before joining the Sharks, Moss worked with the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers, earning AF2 Coach of the Year honors in 2004.

In addition to his extensive experience coaching in the AFL and AF2, Moss also served as the Tight Ends Coach and Training Camp Coordinator of the XFL's Orlando Rage. Moss helped the Rage capture the XFL Eastern Division Championship in 2000.

Moss played high school football in Poca, West Virginia and went on to attend the University of Central Florida. He currently lives in Central Florida with his wife Cindy and their son Jacob.

vs. PHILADELPHIA

Coach Moss is 2-3 all-time against the Soul. This includes records of 2-2 in the regular season and 0-1 in the postseason. Jacksonville beat Philadelphia in the teams' lone matchup in 2011, but the Soul swept three games against the Sharks in 2012, including the conference championship game. The Sharks got back on the winning track against the Soul with a 55-53 victory in Week 6 of this season.

PHILADELPHIA SOUL HEAD COACH CLINT DOLEZEL

Clint Dolezel begins his first season as the Soul's head coach after serving as the team's assistant head coach and offensive coordinator in 2012. Under Dolezel direction, the Soul offense set numerous scoring records on their way to an American Conference Championship. In his playing days, Dolezel began his career in the AFL in 1995 when he was signed by the Milwaukee Mustangs (1995-97). He also played for the Texas Terror (1997), Houston ThunderBears (1998-99), Grand Rapids Rampage (2001-03) and led the team to the XV ArenaBowl Championship. He was later signed by the Las Vegas Gladiators (2004-05) before ending his playing career with the Dallas Desperados (2006-08).

During his tenure with the Desperados, Dolezel became just the third quarterback in AFL history to throw for 700 touchdown passes in 2006. He then surpassed the 800-touchdown mark in 2007, and once again broke another barrier when he reached 900-touchdown plateau in 2008.

After his professional playing career, Dolezel became involved with coaching. He was announced as the offensive coordinator for Florida Firecats of the af2 in 2009. Dolezel was then named head coach for the Dallas Vigilantes during the 2011 season and led them to an 11-7 regular-season mark and a playoff appearance in his AFL rookie head coaching debut.

vs. JACKSONVILLE

Dolezel is 1-1 all-time against the Jacksonville Sharks. In 2011, he led the Dallas Vigilantes to a 75-70 victory over the Sharks on Sea Best Field.

Dolezel's first matchup against the Sharks during his tenure as Philadelphia's head coach came in Week 6 of this season, as Jacksonville won by a 55-53 count.

The Predators look to rebound from a 4-14 finish that saw the team miss the playoffs for the first time since 1991, the team's inaugural season. Appearing in seven ArenaBowls, the Predators have two AFL titles (1998, 2000). Orlando enters 2013 with a lifetime record of 183-119 in the regular season (23-16 post-season record).

NEW ORLEANS VOODOO (5-13):

The New Orleans VooDoo took a big step forward in 2012, improving by five wins to finish with a 8-10 record and earn a trip to the postseason for just the second time in team history. RECORD BREAKERS

In Week 2 against Pittsburgh, the Sharks set a new franchise record by totaling seven sacks in a single game. The previous record stood at 5, set in 2011 against the Iowa Barnstormers.

In Week 2 against Pittsburgh, defensive lineman Jerry Turner tied the franchise single-game record with three sacks in one game. Previously, the feat had only been accomplished by Jason Holman during the 2011 season.

Eight days later, Rashaad Duncan matched the mark tied by Turner by recording three sacks himself in Week 3 against Cleveland.

In Week 4 against New Orleans, the Sharks set a new franchise record with five rushing touchdowns in a single game. Rendrick Taylor matched an individual franchise mark with four rushing touchdowns in that game, and also became the first player in team history with at least 10 rushes in a game (14).

In Week 4 against New Orleans, Jeff Hughley became the first player in franchise history to return a missed field goal for a touchdown.

In Week 10 against Orlando, the Jacksonville defense recovered four fumbles in a single game for the first time in franchise history.

In Week 17 against Spokane, Jeron Harvey surpassed Jomo Wilson's franchise record for most receptions in a single season, Terrance Smith surpassed Micheaux Robinson's franchise record for most interceptions in a single season, and the Shark defense established a new team mark for most sacks in a single season.

A season of dominating pass rushing reached its peak in Week 18, as the Sharks racked up six sacks against New Orleans. The effort pushed Jacksonville past the 2012 San Jose SaberCats for the most team sacks in a single season in AFL history.

Also in Week 18, quarterback Bernard Morris broke his own franchise record for most rushing yards in a single season.

In Week 19, the Sharks notched two defensive touchdowns in a single game for the first time in franchise history. Tracy Belton returned an interception for a score, while Jamaal Fudge picked up a fumble return touchdown.

In the Sharks' first-round playoff win over the Tampa Bay Storm, the team scored 36 points in the fourth quarter - the highest single-quarter total in franchise history. The Sharks had previously scored 35 points in a quarter on two occasions, last accomplishing the feat in the fourth quarter of ArenaBowl XXIV.

SHARK BITES

With a Purpose: In the playoff opener, Shark WR/KR Jeff Hughley returned a kickoff 49 yards on his first touch of the game and didn't slow down from there. Hughley racked up 283 all-purpose yards (173 kick return, 106 receiving, 4 rushing), setting a new single-game franchise playoff record in the process.

Welcome Back: Shark quarterback Bernard Morris returned to action against New Orleans in Week 18. Morris had not played since Week 12 after suffering an injury in the third quarter of the team's loss at Spokane. Including the playoff opener against Tampa, Morris has started each of the last three games. Morris' mobility appears to be back to 100 percent, as he ripped off runs of 27 and 35 yards in the playoff opener against Tampa Bay.

Sack Masters: The Sharks' front four established a new all-time AFL record with 45 sacks this season. The total breaks the previous record of 42, set by the San Jose SaberCats in 2012. The Jacksonville pass rush is a balanced effort, as each of the Sharks' regular starters in the front four has at least 6.5 sacks. At times, the Sharks' sacks come in bunches, as Jerry Turner and Matt Marcorelle each have three games of two or more sacks, while Rashaad Duncan has a three-sack game of his own. The Sharks had just one sack in the playoff opener, but it was a big one, as Matt Marcorelle forced a fumble that Derrick Summers recovered in the end zone with four seconds left in the game.

Record Breaker, Part 1: Wide receiver Jeron Harvey set a new franchise record for most receptions in a single season in Week 17. Harvey finished the regular season with 146 receptions, and also led the Sharks with 1,593 receiving yards and 35 touchdowns.

Record Breaker, Part 2: Terrance Smith pulled down his 12th interception of the season in Week 17, breaking teammate Micheaux Robinson's franchise record for most picks in a single season.

Player Connections: Shark receiver Jeff Hughley was a big part of the Soul's run to ArenaBowl XXV, earning Ironman of the Year honors in his only season with Philadelphia. DB Micheaux Robinson began the 2012 season with the Soul before being traded back to Jacksonville. No players on the Soul's active roster have ever suited up for the Sharks.

Always in the Backfield: Beyond just the impressive sack total, the Jacksonville defense has done a tremendous job of forcing negative plays. The Sharks racked up a league-leading total of 61 tackles for loss this season, while the team's opponents have totaled just 31. Jerry Turner (14.5) and Aaron Robbins (12.5) lead the way in that category, while fellow defensive linemen Matt Marcorelle (10.0) and Rashaad Duncan (7.0) have also brought the pressure. In addition, Tracy Belton has stepped up from his defensive back spot to total 4.5 tackles for loss.

Ground and Pound: The Sharks finished the season as the top rushing team in the Arena Football League, leading the way with an average of 37.0 yards per game. For the season, Jacksonville led all AFL teams with a franchise record of 44 rushing touchdowns.

Breaking Up Is Easy To Do: Defensive back Micheaux Robinson led all AFL players with 33 pass breakups this season, while Tracy Belton chipped in with 20 and Terrance Smith had 12 to go along with his 12 interceptions. Each of those three players averaged better than one pass defended per game. In the playoff opener against Tampa Bay, both Robinson and Smith notched three pass breakups, while Belton totaled two.

Defensive Consistency: A major factor in the Sharks' outstanding defensive performance has been consistency in the starting lineup. Along the defensive line, Jerry Turner, Aaron Robbins, Rashaad Duncan and Matt Marcorelle combined to make 68 out of a possible 72 starts. The health in the secondary has been impressive as well, as Jack linebacker is the only spot at which the "D" has suffered a significant injury in 2013, as Bill Alford missed several weeks in the middle of the season. Defensive backs Terrance Smith, Micheaux Robinson and Tracy Belton started 50 of a possible 54 games.

At the end of the third quarter, New Orleans was able to hold the Sharks to a field goal, then scored on its next drive to make it a three-point game early in the fourth. But Bernard Morris took over in the fourth, scoring a rushing touchdown on each of the Sharks' final two drives to help seal the victory. Micheaux Robinson put the finishing touch on the win with an interception on the last play.

Josh Philpart's 17-yard touchdown pass from Kyle Rowley in the final minute of the half allowed Jacksonville to take a 28-21 lead into the locker room. In the third quarter, the Sharks turned the tide with a pair of defensive touchdowns. First, Tracy Belton jumped a hitch route and snagged his first pick-six as a Shark. On the Storm's very next drive, Jamaal Fudge scooped a fumbled snap off of the turf and sprinted to the end zone for the Sharks' first fumble return touchdown of the season. In a quirk of the schedule and the standings, the Sharks opened the 2013 postseason against the very same Tampa Bay Storm team it had faced the week before. The Sharks started slowly, scoring just 13 points in the first half. Though Jacksonville opened the third quarter with the football, Tampa Bay defensive lineman R.J. Roberts returned a fumble for a touchdown on the second snap of the frame, putting the Storm up by three scores. The Sharks responded, charging back with 56 points in the second half. Jacksonville used a successful onside kick, a two-point pass from holder Jeff Hughley to Marco Capozzoli and a defensive stop to make up the difference, eventually tying the score at 48. The teams traded scores as Tampa Bay went up, 62-55, with 52 seconds left. Jacksonville moved down the field, working the clock until Bernard Morris hit Markee White for a touchdown with eight seconds left.
