**TONIGHT**-The Explorers open a six-game home stand with the first of three against Fargo-Moorhead. Sioux City is playing the RedHawks for the second time this season, having lost three of four at F-M back in late-May and early June (all three losses by one run). The X's will host the RedHawks again for four after the all-star break. Tonight's pitching match-up features Sioux City right-hander Wade Morrison against Fargo right-hander Curtis Camilli. Morrison last pitched July 5<sup>th</sup> in a home loss to Wichita 2-0. He only lasted two-and-two-thirds in his shortest outing and gave up two earned runs on two hits with four strikeouts and four walks. Morrison has lost two straight starts. Camilli's last outing was in relief July 8<sup>th</sup> in a 9-5 loss at home to Gary. He pitched one inning and struck out two with one walk. Camilli's only start with F-M was July 4<sup>th</sup> at home vs. Winnipeg. He took the loss in a 4-1 game and pitched five innings with two strikeouts and two walks. He gave up two runs (one earned) on seven hits. Neither starter has faced the other team this season.

**EXPLORERS INFO**-Sioux City has gone 6-4 in its last ten games, and is on a three-game win streak (five straight road wins) after last night's 2-0 win and sweep at Winnipeg. The Explorers are 5-1 this season against the first-place Goldeyes with all six games played in Winnipeg. The X's have won six of their last nine series with one split. The Explorers are T-10<sup>th</sup> in hitting (.262), T-1<sup>st</sup> in team ERA (3.62), and T-6<sup>th</sup> in fielding (.971). Sioux City sits in last place in the Central, 7.5 games back of first-place Gary. The X's extended home stand features three against Fargo and three against Kansas City and concludes on Wednesday next week. After an off-day Thursday, Sioux City heads down to Wichita for three against the Wingnuts. The Explorers then return home for four against Gary July 21<sup>st</sup> through 24<sup>th</sup>.

**REDHAWKS INFO**-Fargo-Moorhead is 2-8 in its last ten games after yesterday's 2-1 loss at home to Gary. The RedHawks are currently mired in a six-game losing streak, matching their longest of the season. F-M is just 2-13 in its last 15, and is coming off a 0-6 home stand vs. Gary and Winnipeg. They went 2-5 on their last road trip. The RedHawks rank last in hitting (.253), 7<sup>th</sup> in team ERA (4.78), and T-6<sup>th</sup> in fielding (.971). The RedHawks are in third place in the North, 10 games back of first-place Winnipeg. They were a season-high eight games over .500 at 23-15 on June 24<sup>th</sup> before their recent tailspin. F-M is 12-15 on the road, 13-13 at home. The RedHawks are 3-1 against Sioux City this season, and 22-12 vs. the X's all-time in American Association play. This is Fargo's 4<sup>th</sup> season in the AA, after spending 15 years in the Northern League. The RedHawks won five Northern League championships. They've won back-to-back North Division titles in the AA.

**SIoux CITY PITCHING BACK ON TOP**-After allowing only three runs in three games at Winnipeg, the Explorers pitching staff is ranked back in the top spot of the American Association. The X's are tied with Wichita for the league's best ERA. Sioux City has also struck out a league-high 382 batters, 22 more than the next closest team. The Explorers have held opponents to a .253 batting average, which ranks #1 in that category as well.

**PEREZ IN MID-SEASON SURGE**-X's infielder Andres Perez is riding a five-game hit streak. Perez has hit .500 in his last five games, and .385 in the last ten. He has also reached base in 27 of his last 29 games. Perez had a perfect night in Winnipeg Wednesday-going 4-for-4 with a homer, a double, and two singles. He drove in four as well.
