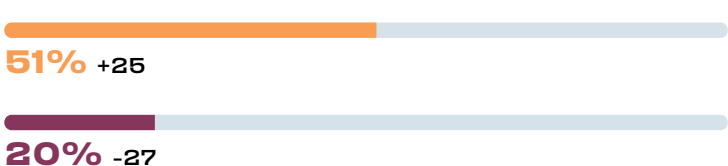

I support U.S. military intervention in a potential escalation of the Ukraine/Russia conflict

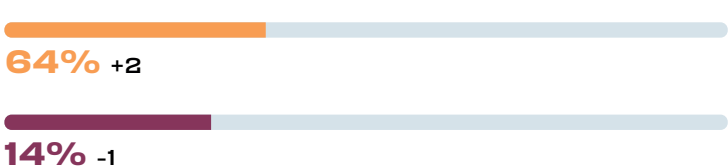
Support for U.S. military intervention in the Russia/Ukraine conflict has steadily declined since the beginning of January.



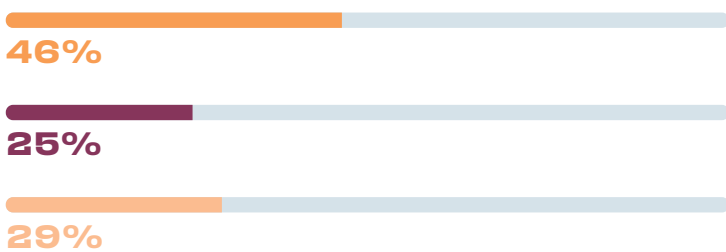
Inflation and the rise in prices of everyday items has had a significant impact on my household

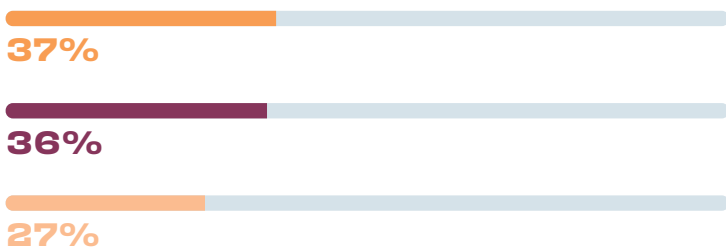

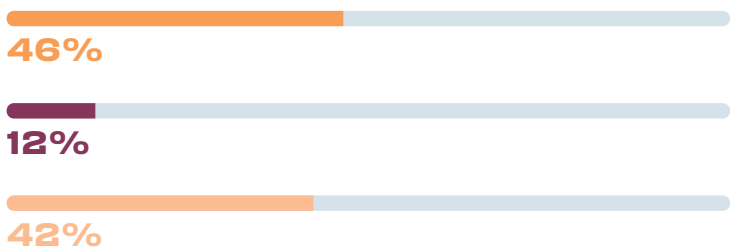

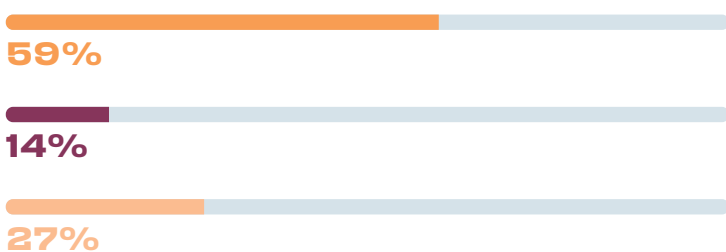
I believe that those that are vaccinated/boosted can now relax COVID precautions and live their lives as they did before the pandemic

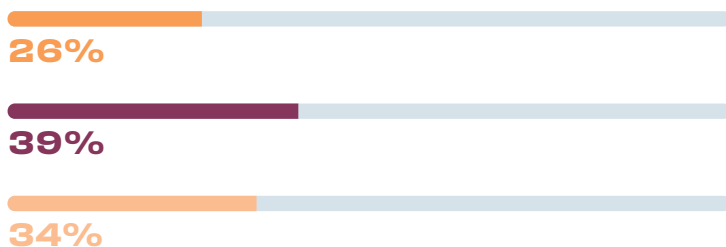

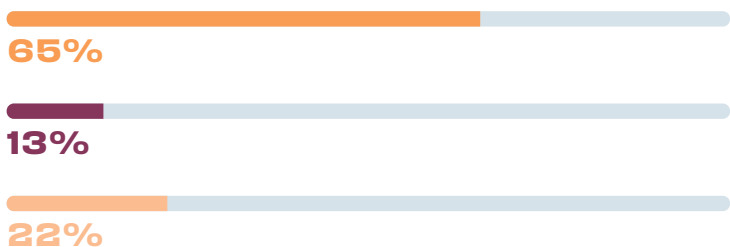
