QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be 16 years old before **July 1, 2019**
- Must be able to pass a 500 yard swim in under 10 minutes
- Must be able pass a 500 yard paddle on a rescue board (no time limit)
- Must possess a current CPR card by **June 15, 2019**
- Must possess a valid Drivers License
- Must have worked at least 1 season as a Del Mar Junior Lifeguard Intern

APPLICATION PACKET

- **Application Form** - PRINT OR TYPE - Illegible applications will not be accepted.
- **CPR Card** - if you posses a current CPR card please submit a Xerox COPY.
- **Driver's License** - Submit a copy of your current driver license.
- **Letter/Essay** – Write and submit a letter/essay about yourself as described in the application.

INTERVIEW

March 16, 2019 Interviews will be held at the 20th St Lifeguard Tower in Del Mar, CA 92014 You will be contacted to arrange a specific time.

SELECTION PROCESS

If you are selected you will be required to:

1. Commit to at least 4 weeks of DMJG summer schedule (does not have to be consecutive)
2. Attend and successfully complete the DMJG Intern training consisting of a 500yard swim & paddle in the open ocean.
3. Possess a current CPR card from the American Heart Association or American Red Cross. Card must be on file with Turtleguard inc. prior to your first day, and must remain valid throughout your term of employment.

NOTE: This will be a formal interview process. It is strongly recommended to practice your interview skills, dress appropriately, and be prepared for questions regarding you knowledge, skills and abilities.
