



S O F I T E L BOGOTA VICTORIA REGIA







Although her training was figurative through academia and teachers, for more than ten years the world of abstraction and color captured her in painting.











My life in Finland and Iceland introduced me to a different relationship with nature and this motivated me to continue creating surfaces inspired on landscapes.








