#### THE EXPERTS

Finally, Chilean eco-journalist **Cata Droguett Parra**, founder of *Mujer Sustentable*, will provide an essential perspective on sustainability and responsibility in the industry; topics for which she has been recognized by WWF, TEDx, and international media.

**Ana de Agosto**, one of the most respected figures in the Puerto Rican wedding industry, will serve as the host of the academic agenda for **Cartagena Wedding Dreams & Wedding Forum 2025**. An industrial psychologist and Ph.D. in education with a focus on leadership, Ana has built a solid career as a wedding planner, educator, and international speaker.

## DREAMS EXPERIENCE

This year's fair introduces the **Dreams Experience**, an open-to-the-public space with free admission, where attendees can enjoy different activities and informal talks with prominent personalities. Among them will be Colombian **Kika Rocha**, one of Latin America's most influential fashion and style figures, with more than two decades of experience in the editorial world and a recurring presence on the most prestigious red carpets.

Also featured will be **María Paola Mejía**, journalist and founder of *La Mesa de María P*, one of Latin America's most influential platforms on table styling, etiquette, protocol, and décor. Joining her in this space will be renowned journalist and anchor **Jessica de la Peña**, along with lifestyle influencers such as **Estefanía Borge, Kimberly Reyes, and Siad Char**, who will showcase their work in an approachable, personal way while also sharing tips with attendees on how to achieve their best style.

#### **POP ART**

One of the major highlights will be the launch of **POP ART**, a showcase dedicated to entrepreneurial talent. Around 15 emerging brands will present innovative proposals in accessories, makeup, apparel, and other wedding-related services.

This platform aims to spotlight new players in the industry, foster creativity, and provide attendees with a comprehensive experience that connects the latest trends with the promotion of local and national entrepreneurship.

#### THE EVENT

Activities will kick off on **Monday, September 22**, with a spectacular fashion show at the **Castillo San Felipe de Barajas**, one of Cartagena's most iconic landmarks, presenting the latest trends by Colombian designer **Andrés Pajón**.

On **Tuesday**, **September 23**, a full day of programming will take place, including the official opening of the fair at the *Gran Pavillon Hall* of the *Centro de Convenciones de Las Américas*, masterclasses with experts, a networking lunch, and a commercial showcase featuring the country's top vendors.
