



Bridgewater State University Online Scholarship Application Step by Step Guide

The BSU annual scholarship application is completed entirely online. Students can submit a single online application and be considered for multiple scholarship opportunities. Based on the information submitted on your application and the data imported from your student file, your application will be auto-matched to various scholarship opportunities if the minimum criteria is met. *There are some scholarships that will require additional information after the general application is submitted.* Please read the details carefully before submitting your application.

Please follow the steps below to complete your application:

Step 1:


Click the “Sign In” button in the upper right hand corner of the screen.

Step 2:

Log in using your BSU credentials (the same as if you were logging in to a computer on campus).

Please note: Be sure you are under the “Applicants and Administrators” tab and not the “References and Reviewers” tab.



Step 3:


Upon logging in, you will be brought to the General Application.

Enter your information directly into this application. Everything with an asterisk is a required field.

You have the option of saving your application if you are not able to complete it all in one sitting. This will allow you to pick up where you left off later on.

If you are finished and ready to submit your application, you can click “Finish and Submit.”

Please note: The “Finish and Submit” button may appear to be grayed out, but you can still click on it.



Step 4:

Once your application has been submitted, you will be directed to a list of recommended opportunities.

The system automatically matches your student record in Banner to potential opportunities. You will need to review each of these to determine whether or not you meet the requirements.

Clicking "Apply" next to each opportunity will allow you to review additional criteria and questions. If qualified, answer the questions for each recommended scholarship and then click "Finish and Submit." Just like the General Application, you also have the option to save your progress and return to it later.
