Thank you letters are a requirement for accepting a scholarship(s) at Sacramento State.

Each scholarship was founded by a donor(s) who values the quality education at Sacramento State and who supports student success.

The Importance of Thanking Your Donor

Scholarship donors generously donate funding to support the educational endeavors of students like you. Thank you letters show them that you are proud of your accomplishments and grateful to them for helping you reach your goals. A well written note from you affirms the value and significance of their contributions and encourages their continued support for students.

Suggestions for Successful Writing

- Express enthusiasm.
- Be clear and concise.
- Proofread your work. Make sure your letter is free from spelling and grammatical errors! Have someone review your letter before submitting.

NOTE: letters with errors or little content will be returned for rewrites.

A Step-By-Step Guide:

- Address the letter Dear (Donor Name or Organization provided in Scholarship Portal)
- Thank the donor for their generosity
- Explain the impact of the scholarship and how it will support your professional, personal and educational goals
- Highlight future plans this can include post-graduation plans, professional development opportunities or personal growth activities
- Close with a final statement of gratitude

Thank You Letter Content

- Experiences or life situations that led you to pursue a degree at Sacramento State
- What you are studying and why
- What you hope to accomplish with your education
- Your career goals and aspirations
- Your involvement with on-campus and off-campus activities and organizations
- How the scholarship has benefitted you personally
- Gratitude for their contribution toward your success

Sample Thank You Letter 1

First paragraph: State the purpose of your letter.

Sample Thank You Letter 2
