
Guidelines for Accessing Federal Student Loan Borrowing History




<u>Instructions for locating federal student loan borrowing history through Studentaid.gov.</u>

- 1. Log onto studentaid.gov using your FSA ID.
- 2. Locate the "My Aid" on your Studentaid.gov **Dashboard**; you will see a pie graph showing any federal loans borrowed.
- 3. If you have **not** borrowed any federal loans, you may upload a picture of the dashboard showing that information.



- 4. If you have borrowed federal loans, Click "View Details."
- 5. Scroll down to "Loan Types" for a detailed breakdown of any federal loans borrowed to date.

6. Once you have located "**Loan Types**," take a screen shot of your federal loan breakdown and **save to** your computer.

- 1. Click on FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN BORROWING HISTORY
- 2. Click Add New File
- 3. Click **Browse** and locate the screen shot of your Federal Borrowing history document
- 4. SELECT the document.
- 5. Click "Save and Keep Editing"
