

THE DR. PATRICK AND DOROTHY SULLIVAN SCHOLARSHIP FUND

For students in the Kenneth W. Monfort College of Business at the University of Northern Colorado

atrick J. Sullivan, MD was born July 29, 1936 in Little Rock, Arkansas. Dr. Sullivan received his medical degree from LSU Medical School in New Orleans in 1961 and an MBA from the University of Colorado, Denver in 1998. Dr. Sullivan, a board certified Urologist, retired captain in the US Army Medical Corps, and entrepreneur, began his medical practice when the family moved to Greeley in 1969.

In addition to a successful medical career, which included a stint as chief of staff at NCMC in 1975 and 1976, Dr. Sullivan served on the District 6 Board of Education and the advisory board of the UNC School of Business. In 1990, Dr. Sullivan was elected to the Colorado House of Representatives. While on the education committee, he was the driving force and the principal sponsor of HB 93-1313, a bill creating academic standards and accountability (CSAP). He received numerous statewide awards for his work in the legislature, especially in the field of education.

Dorothy J. Sullivan was born August 8, 1934 in Welch, West Virginia. She received a BA from William and Mary College in Williamsburg, Virginia in 1956, an MA in Anthropology from UNC in 1985 and an LLD from Denver University in 1995.

Dorothy began teaching at Gove Junior High in Denver in 1959. After the Sullivans were married in 1963, she interrupted her career to raise three daughters.

In addition to being a successful business owner and law school graduate, Dorothy served on the boards of the American Cancer Society, the Greeley Philharmonic Orchestra, CASA, and A Woman's Place. She has also been actively involved in fundraising for United Way and Catholic Charities.

The Sullivans place a strong emphasis on the value of education and lifelong learning. Their three daughters all hold advanced degrees. They have endowed these academic scholarships because of their close ties to the Greeley and Weld community.
