Gary Walker was a standout football player from Wiggins, Colorado. Upon graduating from high school he attended the University of Northern Colorado on a football scholarship. He started as a defensive end for the Bears for three years. Gary graduated from UNC with a bachelor's degree in marketing and studied at the post graduate level.

Henry Walker was also a star football player at Wiggins High School. He followed his Uncle Gary's footsteps, and in 1968 he earned a football scholarship to attend UNC. Gary was a business administration major.

After college Gary and Henry became owners of *Bears Inn* bar in Greeley. *Bears Inn* was popular with UNC athletes, and Gary and Henry learned from the baseball players how difficult it was for the baseball team to raise enough money to successfully compete at the Division I level. Gary and Henry met with legendary baseball coach Tom Petroff to discuss fundraising possibilities. After that meeting in 1972, Gary and Henry's contributions to the university, as well as the proceeds from the Walker Memorial Golf Tournament, were directed to the UNC baseball program.

The Gary and Henry Walker Baseball Scholarship was established by the Walker family as a legacy to Gary and Henry, and as a meaningful connection for Gary's children, Nik and Paige, and for Henry's children, Cassidy and Mitch, to their fathers' commitment to the UNC baseball program. Through the efforts of the Walker family, a portion of the proceeds from the Walker Memorial Golf Tournament are directed to the Gary and Henry Walker Baseball Scholarship.
