Hideo Hibino (1930-) attended Colorado State College (now UNC) from 1951 to 1952 as a recipient of Garioa-Fulbright Scholarship. A native of Japan, Hibino continued his education during the postwar years and was a professor of English and cross-cultural studies from 1980 through 2000 at Kinran College in Osaka, Japan. Hibino, who co-authored high school textbooks and published numerous articles on English linguistics, says, "Being one of the first post-war students to attend an American university, I know well the many small difficulties that students from other countries have."
