About Forty and Eight

The 40 & 8 Voiture 751 Winnebago County Scholarship was established by a local independent fraternal organization of American Veterans. The Forty & Eight began in 1920, with local ties to the American Legion. The organization was named La Société des Quaranté Hommes et Huit Chevaux (the Society of Forty Men and Eight Horses). During World War II, the Forty & Eight began awarding nursing scholarships. By September of 1942, over 100 nurses had received education grants. The local 40 & 8 Voiture 751 Chapter continues this tradition by providing an annual scholarship available to UW Oshkosh nursing students.

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Scholarship Criteria:

1. Applicants must be enrolled full-time in the UW Oshkosh College of Nursing traditional BSN program. Applicants must have at least sophomore standing at the time of application.
2. Preference will be given to applicants who are currently enlisted in any branch of the military, were previously enlisted in any branch of the military, or who have an immediate family member that is currently, or was previously, enlisted in any branch of the military.

The Award:

1. To receive the award, the recipient is required to attend the Nurses Training Dinner generally held in August.
2. The award may be renewed for a second year provided funding is available and the recipient remains in good standing and enrolled in the College of Nursing.

Deadline to submit applications is Friday, May 10, 2024. Finalists will be notified Wednesday, July 24, 2024. No late applications will be accepted.
