Re: Notice of Facility Closing

We are sending this notice to you in accordance with the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (“WARN”). We are writing to inform you that the Dunedin Plant of The Coca-Cola Company, located at 427 San Christopher Dr., Dunedin, Florida is expected to be permanently closed in the near future.

It is anticipated this closure will take place on May 31, 2024, with layoffs starting on April 5, 2024 and ending on May 31, 2024. All positions and jobs at the facility will be eliminated during this time period, and approximately 198 employees will be affected, although it is possible that one or more employees will remain employed for a limited time (no more than 60 days) after the facility is closed to assist with administrative tasks related to the closing of the facility. More than sixty days notification was given to our workers on February 5, 2024. Employees are not represented by a union and there are no bumping rights.

This announcement and timetable are based on the best information currently available. Various factors may still affect these plans and the timing of employee separations. Employees will be informed of any changes as additional information becomes available.
