Trading Authority

Life is full of moments when you may not be available to manage the details — sometimes, other priorities require your focus. When it comes to your investments, trading authority provides a simple safeguard: it allows you to formally appoint someone you trust to place trades on your account if you are unavailable.

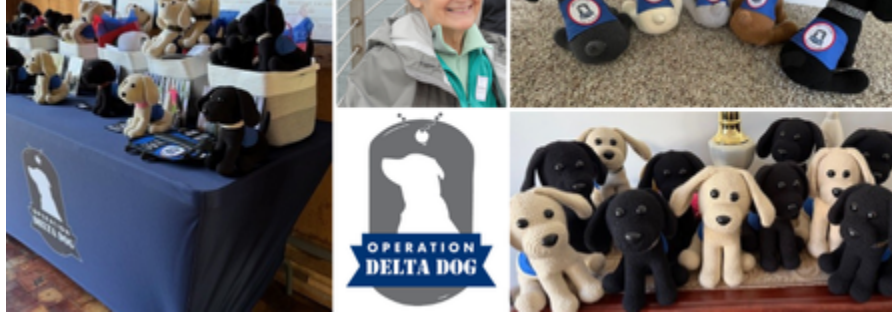
There are two types of trading authorization you could consider granting:

- **Limited Trading Authorization (LTA)** authorizes an agent to buy, sell, and trade stocks, bonds, and other securities, within the bounds of the terms and conditions set by the account holder. Someone with LTA cannot withdraw funds.
- **Full Trading Authorization (FTA)** authorizes an agent to act with all capabilities of LTA *and* to remove cash from the account for the benefit of the account holder.

Appointing a trusted relative or friend to have trading authority should be a carefully considered decision. If this is something you're pondering, let [Bonnie](#) be your sounding board and schedule a time to speak with her.

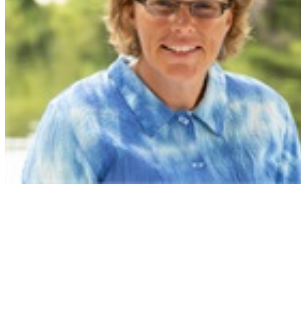
