Happy Spring from Sterk Financial! 2023 has had a fairly volatile start. Here are a few economic observations:

- Q1 had many days up, and many days down...but the Dow* finished the quarter within a couple hundred points of where it started.
- Bank failures dominated the headlines, sending shockwaves of concern across the nation.
- Inflation continues to be an issue, but we have seen the interest rate hikes slow down a bit.
- The war in Ukraine continues to drag on, keeping energy prices especially high in the European countries.
- Corporate earnings were better than anticipated for many companies and this is still the driving factor that influences the market.

Our best outlook - we will continue to see volatility in the markets as the Fed tries to reign in continued inflation and stabilize the banking sector.

Of note, the Secure Act 2.0 had a provision that will take effect next year, affecting people age 50+ with incomes over \$145,000. It will force any catch-up contributions into the Roth side of your 401k. If this impacts you, and you do not already have a Roth IRA outside of your plan, you may be affected by some very complex 5-year clock rules.
