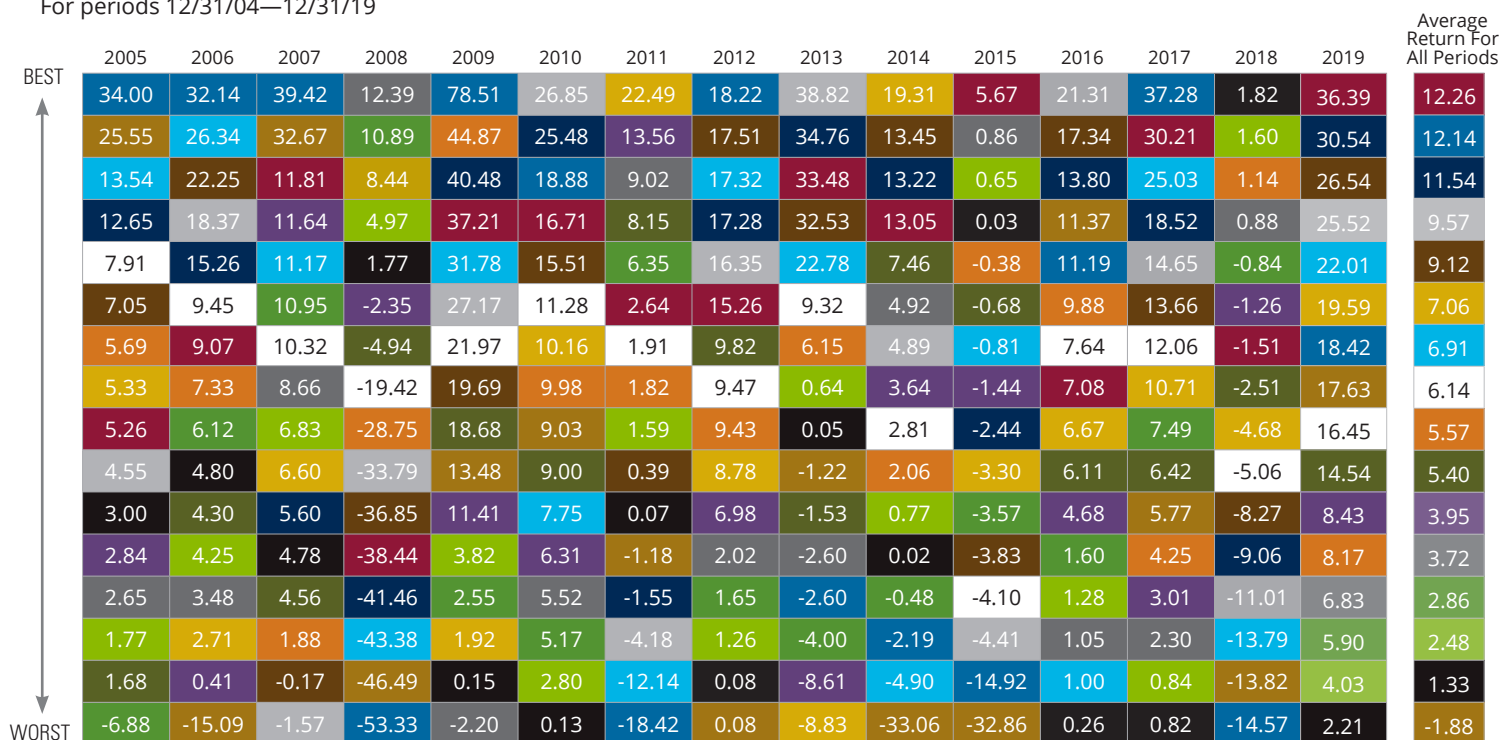


Diversification Never Goes out of Favor
