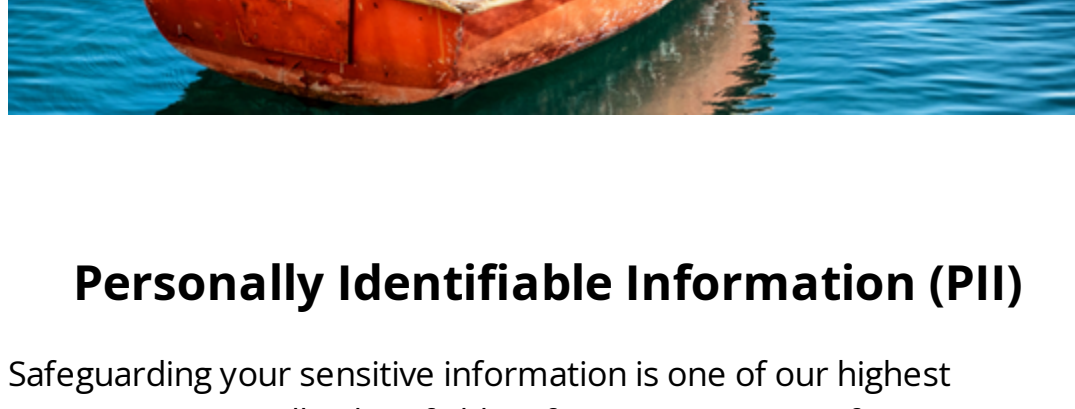

Personally Identifiable Information (PII)

Safeguarding your sensitive information is one of our highest priorities. Personally identifiable information, or PII, refers to any data which can be used to identify you as an individual.

Examples of PII include:

- Date of birth
- Postal address
- Account information (like balances and statements)

Protecting your PII is more than just a company policy — it is a legal requirement. We do not share any of your information with anyone but you without your consent. We can't talk to your spouse, your child, or even your pet if we don't have your permission!

There are legitimate reasons why you may want or need someone to access that information. Typically, this may include your spouse, an attorney, or an accountant. In that case, we require you to complete and sign a **Permission to Disclose PII** form.

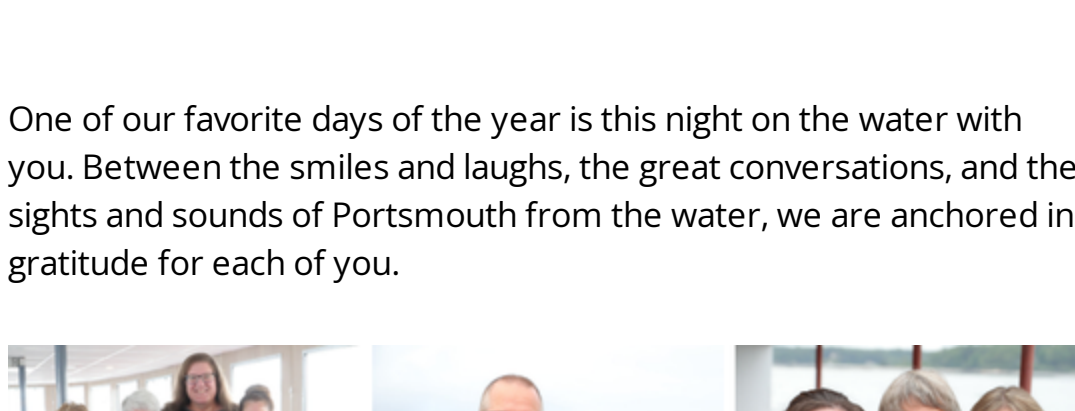
This form details who we have permission to talk to and what information you want them to have access to. It's a simple step that ensures your information stays between you and those you authorize, while allowing us to best serve you.

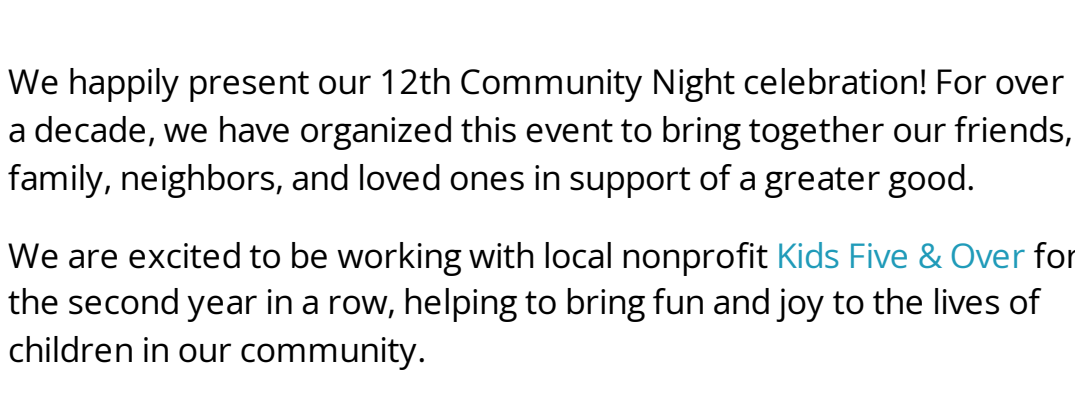

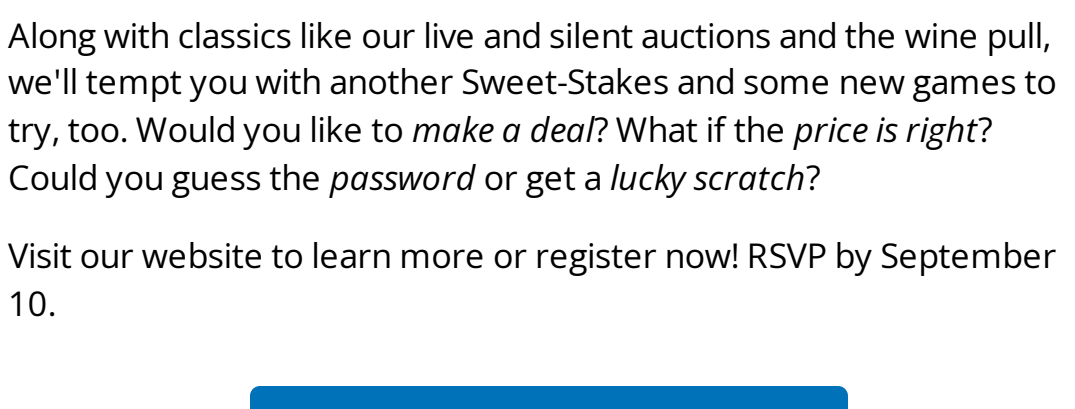

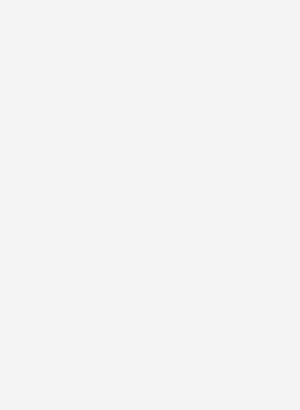
