Cabin Trail **15 to 20 Minutes** **Green Arrows** **Easy**
Beginning at Studio left of Dining Hall. Straight down ridge, sharp left to gravel road.

Mountain Top Trail **20 to 30 Minutes** **Red Arrows** **Easy**
Encircles top of property. Beginning at Studio, left of dining hall. Curves left below lodges and amphitheater, passes through pasture, comes out at Wildacres garden. Up gravel drive to barn below Gazebo.

Azalea Trail* **30 to 45 Minutes** **Dark Blue Arrows** **Easy**
Starts from Mountain Top Trail, comes out on gravel road.
*** Temporarily Closed**

Loop Trail **1 to 1.5 hours** **White Arrows** **Easy**
Mountain Top Trail to Azalea Trail*. Cross gravel road. Down steps, left to gravel driveway, turn right. Look for Loop Trail sign on left, back to gravel road, left and back up to Wildacres.
*** Azalea Trail is temporarily closed. Use Cabin Trail to gravel road, then left on gravel road to reach steps on right to Loop Trail.**

Cascade Trail **2 to 2.5 hours** **Light Blue Arrows** **Moderate**
Mountain Top Trail to Azalea Trail*. Cross gravel road. Down steps, left to gravel driveway, turn right. Left at large house at bottom of driveway. Cascade Trail is on the right. At open field follow O'Dear Trail sign to Wildacres Road near chimney. Turn left on gravel road back up to Wildacres.
*** Azalea Trail is temporarily closed. Use Cabin Trail to gravel road, then left on gravel road to reach steps on right to Loop Trail.**

Deer Lick Gap Trail **2.5 to 3 hours** **Orange Arrows** **Moderate**
Paved driveway, right on gravel road. Left on logging road with chain and white pipe. Follow trail to Deer Lick Gap Overlook on Blue Ridge Parkway. Right on Parkway, through tunnel (take a flashlight), right on Wildacres Road and back to entrance.

Rose's Creek Trail **2 to 2.5 hours** **Yellow Arrows** **Difficult**
Mountain Top Trail to Azalea Trail*, across gravel road to Rose's Creek sign on right. Downhill to creek. Fish Hatchery is another 1.5 miles across creek. Come back same way or arrange for car pick-up.
*** Azalea Trail is temporarily closed. Use Cabin Trail to gravel road, then left on gravel road to reach steps on right to Loop Trail.**

Three Knobs Trail **3 to 3.5 hours one way** **White Blazes** **Most Strenuous**
Deer Lick Trail to Deer Lick Gap. Left at double white blazes to left of fallen log. Comes out on Blue Ridge Parkway just beyond Three Knobs overlook at Crabtree Meadows sign. Turn right to return by Parkway or arrange for car pick-up.
