Golden's Fantastik has all the desired features you need in a floor polish. Instead of a traditional wax compound, Fantastik is a water based polymer emulsion used as a floor polish to impart a long lasting lustre.

How is Fantastik Unique?

Fantastik is a modern, water-based polymer emulsion used as a floor polish.

Long lasting formulation.

Slip and scuff resistant.

Self levelling.

Will not discolour.

How it Works:

Tough zinc cross-link co-polymer emulsion offers excellent detergent resistance.

Polyethylene contributes to its slip and scuff resistance.

Layered, thin coat applications ensure a strong and durable finish and lustre.

Resins and levelling agent introduce the self levelling feature for ease of use.

Why Use Golden's Fantastik?

- **Economical.** Thin coat applications on a variety of surfaces. 1 litre covers 166 sq metres.
- Versatile. Can be used on sealed surfaces such as floors, marble and wood as well as linoleum, asphalt, tiles, vinyl, asbestos and rubber.
- Easy to clean with Golden's LDC (1:3).
- Easy to remove with Golden's Super 10 (1:3).
- Patchable. Not necessary to strip between applications.
- No powdering or discolouration.

How to use Fantastik: Floors

- Strip floors of old wax using hot water and Super 10 (1:3).
- Apply liberally and allow to soak. Mop the old wax once it starts to lift or curl.
- For more stubborn waxed surfaces, a mixture of 60g G1, 120ml Super 10 and 30 ml LDC in 5 litres of hot water can be applied as above.
- Ensure surface is dry.

Application:

Apply Fantastik thinly and evenly in one direction. Avoid circular motions.

Apply up to 3 coats allowing adequate time (up to 1 hour) for drying between coats. This allows a harder finish that lasts longer and resists scuffing more effectively.

Maintenance:

Wash the polished surface with LDC on a regular basis.

After washing, one cupful of Fantastik can be added to a bucket of water and mopped over the entire floor to enhance the shine. This can be done on an as needed basis. (The floor must be clean so as not to incorporate dirt into the polished surface)

■ Touch up:

High Traffic areas may be patched by re-application of one layer. Ensure that the surface has been cleaned with Golden's LDC (Light Duty Concentrate) prior to re-application.
